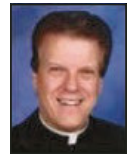

My Dear People of St. Catherine,



This Sunday, Good Shepherd Sunday, is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. **Pope Francis**, in his message says: *Each year, the World Day of Prayer for Vocations invites us to reflect on the precious gift of the Lord's call to each of us, as members of his faithful pilgrim people, to participate in his loving plan and to embody the beauty of the Gospel in different states of life. Hearing that divine call, which is far from being an imposed duty – even in the name of a religious ideal – is the surest way for us to fulfill our deepest desire for happiness. Our life finds fulfillment when we discover who we are, what our gifts are, where we can make them bear fruit, and what path we can follow in order to become signs and instruments of love, generous acceptance, beauty and peace, wherever we find ourselves. ... This Day is dedicated in a particular way to imploring from the Father the gift of holy vocations for the building up of his Kingdom: "Ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest" (Lk 10:2).* /www.vatican.va/

Cardinal Blase Cupich has called World Day of Prayer for Vocations as an Annual Vocations Appeal within the Archdiocese. Every year, World Day of Prayer for Vocations falls on Good Shepherd Sunday. We see in Jesus, the Good Shepherd, the heart of every calling. He says, "A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." The mission of Jesus culminated in his self-sacrificing love. He gave himself so that we might live. This is the great mystery of love present in the Eucharist: "This is my body, given up for you. This is my blood, poured out for you." Everyone is called, and everyone has a vocation in the Church. /vocations.archchicago.org/

On this Good Shepherd Sunday, I ask you to make a special effort to pray to the Lord for more vocations, especially to the priesthood and religious life.

- Keep Priests and Religious Sisters and Brothers, both living and deceased, in your prayers.
- Encourage your children to consider a vocation as a Priest or Religious.
- Pray the Rosary for more young men and women to respond to God's call.
- Tell stories to your children and grandchildren about Priests and Sisters you knew who made a difference in your lives.
- Spend a little time in our Adoration Chapel before the Blessed Sacrament to offer up this time for vocations.

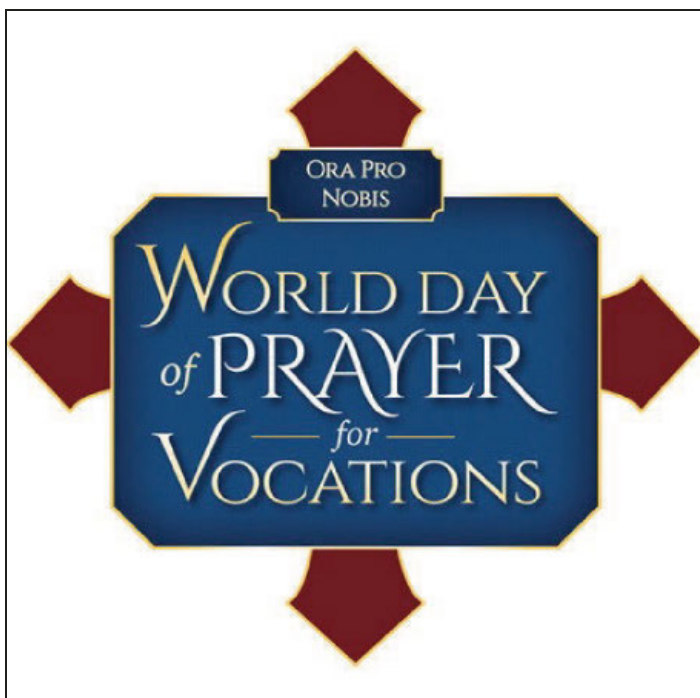
I came across this little bulletin article for vocations:

Teach Your Children to Use GPS

After Mass today, have a conversation with your children or grandchildren, asking, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" After a few moments of discussion, ask, "Who do you think God wants you to be when you grow up?" Emphasize to your children that God has a specific plan in mind for them, and that following God's plan is the surest way to happiness. Every life decision—which college to attend, whom to date, which job to pursue, whether to enter seminary, whom to marry—should be undertaken only after praying for God's guidance. In other words, encourage kids to navigate life using **GPS**—**God's Positioning System**.

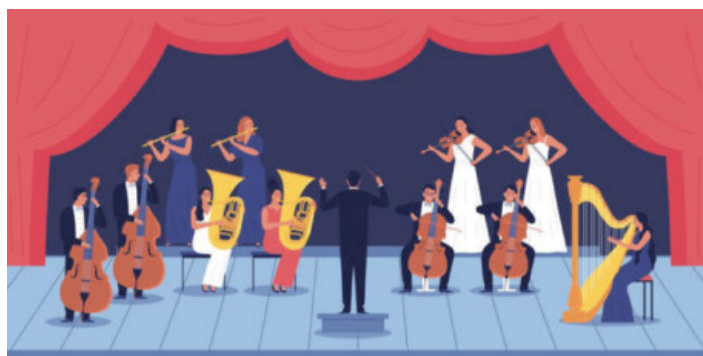

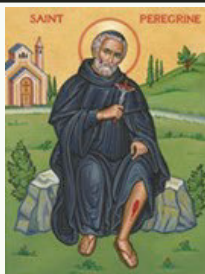

St. Peregrine is the patron saint for persons suffering from illnesses of all types in particular cancer. Saint Peregrine was healed of a cancerous ulcer on his leg which was considered beyond saving. The fame of this event in 1325 spread rapidly around the western Church.

Christians, and especially the sick, began to invoke his name and seek his intercession for the relief of their suffering and even for a cure from sickness. The canonization of St. Peregrine in 1726 increased people's devotion to him which spread to the universal Church.

St. Catherine of Alexandria will begin offering a Novena to St. Peregrine at 7:00pm in the church. The Novena will be held for 9 Mondays. All are welcome.

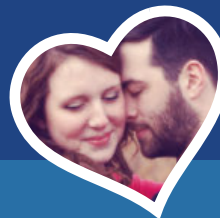
