



Statement of Cardinal Cupich on the death of Pope Benedict XVI

Today we join Pope Francis and Catholics across the world in mourning the death of Pope Benedict XVI who has gone home to the God he served faithfully.

Throughout his life as a scholar and as a churchman, he showed us what it means to fulfill the ancient command to love God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your mind. As the last pope who attended the Second Vatican Council, he has served as a bridge to the future, reminding us all that the reform and renewal of the Church is ongoing. Resigning in 2013, the Year of Faith, Pope Benedict XVI taught us that belief in God means completely placing our trust in Divine Providence. Today we pray as Pope Francis did earlier this year,

"May St. Joseph help us to live the mystery of death in the best possible way. For a Christian, the good death is an experience of the mercy of God, who comes close to us even in that last moment of our life."

Lord, let your perpetual light shine on your servant Joseph Ratzinger, Pope Benedict XVI, and may he rest in peace.

My Dear People of St. Catherine,

Our entire Church as well as the world mourns the death of our Emeritus Holy Father, Benedict XVI. I would like share in this letter some reflections on the 264th successor to St. Peter. This information has been shared by the USCCB (the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops) on their website: https://www.usccb.org/popes/pope-benedict-xvi.

A short biography: On April 18, 2005, Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger was elected the 264th successor of Saint Peter and chose the name Benedict XVI. His papacy testifies to both a scholarly churchman, having extensively studied theology and philosophy, and pastoral sensitivity. When elected Pope at age 78, he didn't anticipate traveling the globe given his age and health, but quickly realized that the best way to reach the people of God was to go to them. He attended the first World Youth Day in Germany just months after his election. On February 28, 2013, Pope Benedict announced his resignation, becoming the first Pope in almost 600 years to resign from the papacy. Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI passed away on December 31, 2022 at the age of 95. The full biography of Pope Benedict XVI is on the Vatican website.

Pope Benedict Quotes:

"Being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person, which gives life a new horizon and a decisive direction." (Deus Caritas Est, 1)

The ways of the Lord are not easy, but we were not created for an easy life, but for great things, for goodness." (Address to German Pilgrims who had come to Rome to attend the Inauguration of his Pontificate, April 25, 2005)

"God is not distant: He is 'Emmanuel,' God-with-us. He is no stranger: He has a face, the face of Jesus." (Urbi et Orbi, December 25, 2010)

"Dear friends, may no adversity paralyze you. Be afraid neither of the world, nor of the future, nor of your weakness. The Lord has allowed you to live in this moment of history so that, by your faith, His name will continue to resound throughout the world." (Prayer Vigil with Young People before 26th World Youth Day in Madrid, 2011)

The Cross reminds us that there is no true love without suffering, there is no gift of life without pain." (General Audience, September 17, 2008)

If we allow the love of Christ to change our heart, then we can change the world. This is the secret of authentic happiness." (Apostolic Journey to Mexico and the Republic of Cuba, March 2012)

This past Thursday, our Episcopal Vicar of Vicariate V (Southwest side parishes), Bishop Andrew Wypych offered up a special Liturgy for the repose of the soul of Pope Benedict XVI. St. Albert the Great parish was the gracious host. Many Priests, including myself, and many of our faithful parishioners were there in prayer. As Pope Francis said: *Together, we want to say: "Father, into your hands we commend his spirit.*"




