





My Dear People of St. Catherine,

Child Jesus.

When does the season of Christmas end? Since Vatican II, the last day of Christmas has been the Baptism of our Lord in the River Jordan by John the Baptist. This feast follows the Feast of the Epiphany, which commemorates the visit of the Magi to the

I wish to thank so many of you have helped to make our parish Christmas celebrations so prayerful, meaningful and beautiful: our church cleaners for Christmas, those who helped to put up the church decorations, as well as put them away, those who setup the Alexandria Center for our family Christmas Eve Mass, our children who participated in the pageant for the Christmas Eve Mass under the direction of Theresa Ward, all our choirs and cantors who practiced so hard, with the direction of Phil Caffee, those who kept our poinsettias watered and looking fresh, and our maintenance staff for displaying the nativity scene on our south gym wall which is no easy task. I am grateful to our liturgical ministers; our videographers, clickers, Eucharistic Ministers, lectors, and ushers. Also, a special thank you to Pat Kerrigan, our most dedicated head usher and sacristan, who probably spent as much time in church as Fr. Fred and myself. If I forgot to mention anyone, it is unintentional. I also would like to thank all of you who made a special Christmas gift to St. Catherine parish. Your gift is an important source of revenue for our parish operations. Finally, I would like to personally thank all of you for your Christmas cards and gifts. Though I am not the best of finding time to send personal thank you notes, your Christmas greetings are truly appreciated.

So when does Christmas end? For some traditions, like the Polish tradition, the last day of Christmas is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple, February 2. This feast comes 40 days after the Nativity (the birth) of our Lord, mirroring the 40 days of Lent. This feast day also celebrates the Purification of Mary, which was required by the Mosaic Law forty days after the birth of a child. I enjoyed listening to several Christmas songs on the Feast of the Presentation.

In the mysterious encounter between Simeon and Mary, the Old and New Testaments are joined. Together the aging prophet and the young mother give thanks for this Light which has kept the darkness from prevailing. It is the Light which shines in the heart of human life: Christ, the Saviour and Redeemer of the world, 'a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for the glory of his people Israel.' – Saint John Paul II

This feast is also known as Candlemas Day. It is the day the candles that are used in church are blessed, reminding us that Jesus is the Light to the Nations. These blessed candles are then used to bless our throats on the Feast of St. Blaise. The Roman emperor Licinius, began a persecution of Christians and Blaise was found in prayer. As he was being hauled off to prison, a mother came with her young son who was choking on a fish bone stuck in his throat. At Blaise's blessing, the child was able to cough up the bone. Bishop Blaise refused to sacrifice to pagan idols and was martyred for his faith.




Each member serves a three year term. Members are required to attend a monthly meeting held on the second Tuesday of each month as well as volunteer to sell TRIP usually twice per quarter.

St. Peregrine is the patron saint for persons suffering from illnesses of all types in particular cancer. Saint Peregrine was healed of a cancerous ulcer on his leg which was considered beyond saving. The fame of this event in

1325 spread rapidly around the western Church.

Christians, and especially the sick, began to invoke his name and seek his intercession for the relief of their suffering and even for a cure from sickness. The canonization of

St. Peregrine in 1726 increased people's devotion to him which spread to the universal Church.






















Our 8th graders presented their science fair projects to judges as the initial round of competition for the Illinois Junior Academy of Science.




