

My Dear People of St. Catherine,

All parishes of the Archdiocese are part of the Renew My Church Journey. The first stage has been a structural renewal of our parishes. Many parishes have been merged, some even closed, and others have remained without any change to structure, as is the case with St. Catherine. In order to be a vital parish, parishes needed the necessary resources and spiritual support of their parishioners.

The second stage of the Renew My Church Journey is a spiritual renewal of our parishes. We are moving into this next phase "Building a New Reality," guided by the mission imperatives to "Make Disciples – Build Community – Inspire Witness "

Make Disciples: Jesus Christ is calling each of us to invite others to a lifelong relationship with Him as Disciples of His. We need to identify new, outward-reaching ways to bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to others in our parish.

Build Community: "We are people of God, invited to live the faith not individually or in isolation, but in the community, as a people that is loved and dear to God."—Pope Francis. Our renewal efforts must focus on new ways to create vibrant parish life and build community.

Inspire Witness: "We are called to bear witness to Jesus right where we live, in our families, at work, everywhere, even just by giving the light of a smile, a light that is not our own - it comes from Jesus."-Pope Francis.

As we move forward with this next phase, during this Lent, the Archdiocese will make use of two surveys. I am grateful for Fr. Fred being the "point person" for this. The first survey, the "Priest Leadership Inventory," is to be taken by all active priests. This is intended to help priests' personal growth and help the Archdiocese plan for ongoing priest leadership.

The second survey, the "Disciple Maker Index," all active parishioners will be asked to complete. This anonymous 75 question survey takes about fifteen minutes to complete. It is an invitation to let your voice be heard by reflecting on where you are at in your own spiritual growth, as well as helping our parish plan for the future. As we begin the most holy season of the 40 days of Lent, I invite you to make this time more holy by joining together in prayer and reflection. Attend weekday Mass, either in the morning at 8:30am or on Tuesday evenings at 6:30pm, and the Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 6:30pm. The day before Ash Wednesday is known in various cultures as Fat Tuesday or Mardi Gras or Paczki Day (jelly or fruit filled pastries). It is the day of feasting before we begin the fasting of Lent.



St. Peregrine is the patron saint for persons suffering from illnesses of all types in particular cancer. Saint Peregrine was healed of a cancerous ulcer on his leg which was considered beyond saving. The fame of this event in



1325 spread rapidly around the western Church.

Christians, and especially the sick, began to invoke his name and seek his intercession for the relief of their suffering and even for a cure from sickness. The canonization of

St. Peregrine in 1726 increased people's devotion to him which spread to the universal Church.



Who? Any St. Catherine parishioner, or anyone seeking a deeper relationship with Christ.





Lenten Fasting and Abstinence Regulations

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent. The following fasting and abstinence regulations are observed:

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years of age and older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years of age. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

The special Paschal fast and abstinence are observed on Good Friday and, where possible, on Holy Saturday. On these days, Christians prepare themselves by these disciplines in anticipation of the renewal of their baptismal commitment on Easter.

From its earliest days, the Church has urged the baptized and the catechumens to observe the threefold discipline of fasting, almsgiving, and prayer as a preparation for the celebration of Easter. Failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such days must be considered serious.

During Lent, the Church encourages attendance at daily Mass, self-imposed times of fasting, and generosity to local, national, and worldwide programs of sharing.

Rony Figueroa is a farmer who grows corn, beans and bananas. He lives in the Dry Corridor of Honduras—an area impacted by high temperatures and lack of rain. His crops often struggle during the dry season. Rony was invited to join a CRS project where he learned new farming techniques, as well as how to care for the land and natural resources. He was able to repair an old reservoir and install an irrigation system so that his crops can grow even if it doesn't rain. Today, Rony can feed his family, pay for his son Emilson to attend a soccer academy and help people in his community.






