**This Thursday, March 9, at 7:30 pm,
St. Catherine is privileged to host an evening of
information and reflection on the Permanent
Diaconate.**

This Evening of Discernment is sponsored by the Deacons from the parishes in Vicariate V, in conjunction with Vicariate V Ministry Commission. St. Catherine has not had a Deacon serve us for a number of years. Men and their wives are invited to this evening to explore the Permanent Diaconate. Maybe God is calling you to serve Him in this ministry. No commitment is expected. Rather this evening is intended to explore the ministry of the Permanent Diaconate, answer any questions you may have, and explain more what a Deacon does. Those who are curious and want to learn more please join us. I am grateful for the Deacons of Vicariate V for organizing this event.

The following is adapted from the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis website article by Fr. Michael Van Sloun:

What is a deacon and what does he do?

The word "deacon" is derived from the Greek words diakonia, service, and diakonos, variously translated as servant, helper, attendant, or minister. Phil 1:1 acknowledges the evolving concept of diaconal ministry in the early Church.

The diaconate, deacon, is conferred by a bishop by the laying on of hands, and it is one of the three degrees of the Sacrament of Holy Orders. The other two degrees are the Priesthood, and Bishop. Deacons, then, are ordained clergy who are not priests, and their special role is to assist priests.

A deacon assists the priest at Mass, proclaiming the Gospel, possibly preaching the homily, and distributing Holy Communion.

A deacon assists the priest outside of Mass when he administers the Sacrament of Baptism; visits the sick, brings Communion to the dying (Viaticum). presides prayer services; officiates at wakes, funerals, and burial services; and witnesses marriages. Deacons are able to bless religious articles.

As ministers of service, there are many options for deacons to perform charitable good works: outreach to the poor; the visitation of the sick, either at home, in nursing homes, or in hospitals; the care of inmates in prisons and jails; the teaching of sacramental preparation and religious education classes; and various administrative duties; naming some of the major roles.

A permanent deacon must be at least thirty-five years of age for ordination and have completed a thorough formation program. If married, wives and family play a vital role in formation and discernment.

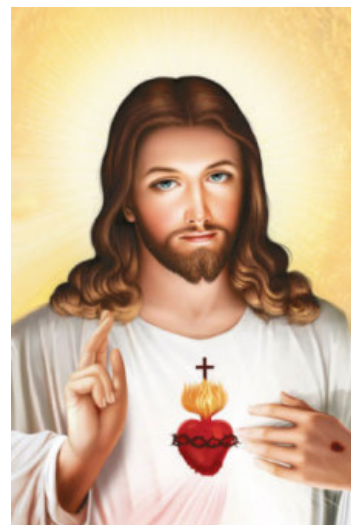

"Our soul waits for the LORD, who is our help and our shield. May your kindness, O LORD, be upon us who have put our hope in you." - Psalm 33

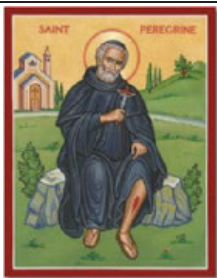

St. Peregrine is the patron saint for persons suffering from illnesses of all types in particular cancer. Saint Peregrine was healed of a cancerous ulcer on his leg which was considered beyond saving. The fame of this event in 1325 spread rapidly around the western Church.

Christians, and especially the sick, began to invoke his name and seek his intercession for the relief of their suffering and even for a cure from sickness. The canonization of St. Peregrine in 1726 increased people's devotion to him which spread to the universal Church.

St. Catherine of Alexandria will begin offering a Novena to St. Peregrine at 7:00p.m. in the church. The Novena will be held for 9 Mondays. All are welcome.
