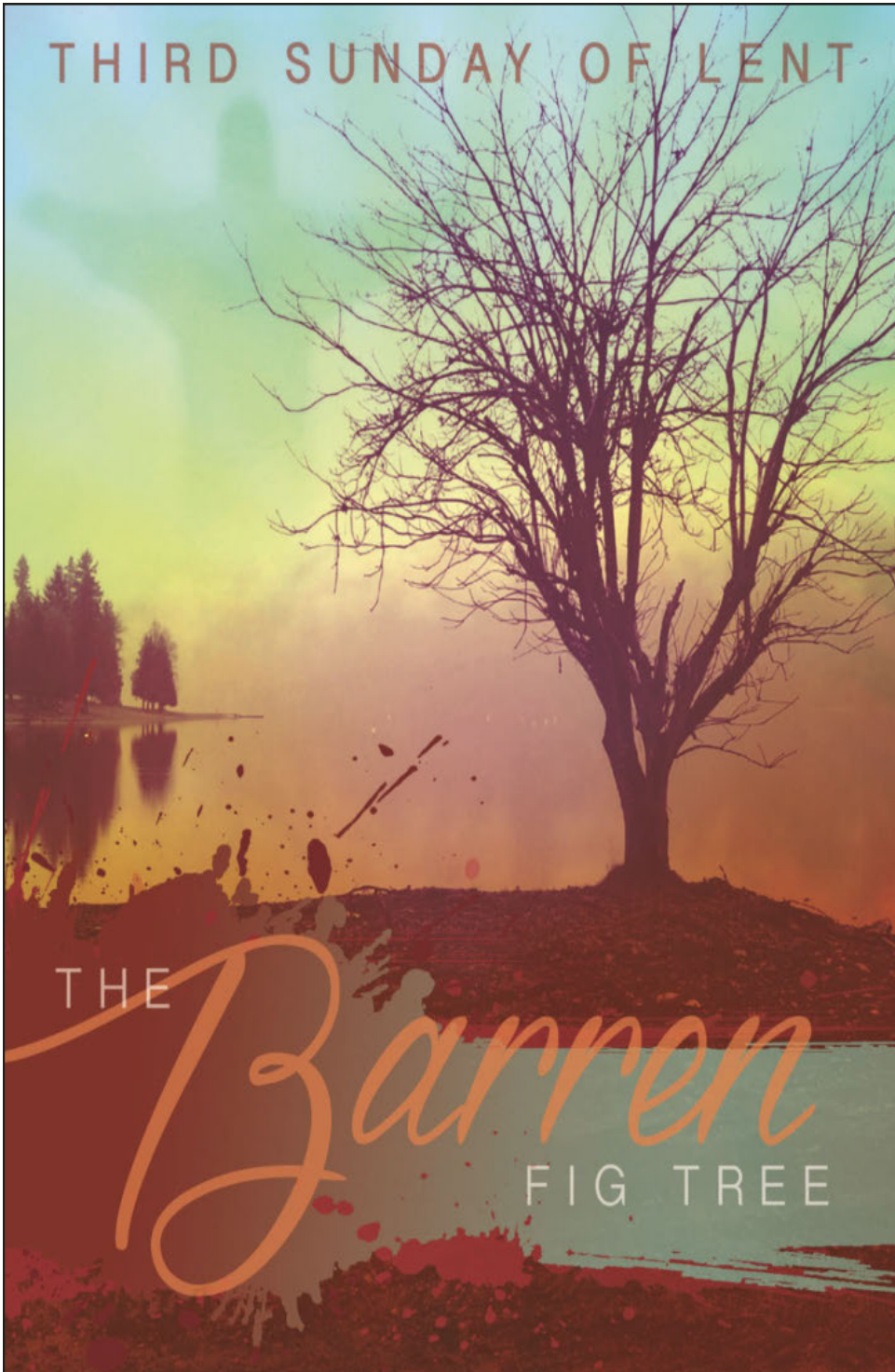

My Dear People of St. Catherine,

Congratulations to our Confirmandi. Our students were confirmed in the Holy Spirit, last Sunday, by Bishop Kevin Birmingham. It was a beautiful celebration of faith. Bishop Kevin Birmingham connected well with our students



and parents. He mentioned how he had known "Fr. Zi" since he was 11 years old, through one of Quigley South Preparatory Seminary recruitment programs. Thanking him for doing our Confirmation, I mentioned he was one of my students whom I taught at Quigley South. Last May, he celebrated his 25th anniversary of priesthood ordination. I was a teacher in the high preparatory seminary for 22 years, Quigley South and downtown Archbishop Quigley. I take pride in all my students, and a special pride in those who have been ordained priests. I spoke briefly to our Confirmandi, encouraging them as they live out their faith; perhaps the Holy Spirit may one day prompt some of them to answer the call to priesthood or consecrated religious life.

This past Tuesday, we welcomed Deacon Bob Puhala, Director of Diaconal Studies, who shared his own call to be a Permanent Deacon, and how his wife supported him and joined him in the formation process. Those in attendance included three men from our parish and their wives. Having extended an invitation to a number of men of faith after Mass and by email last weekend, I pray that maybe a few more will be interested in learning more about the permanent diaconate at some time.

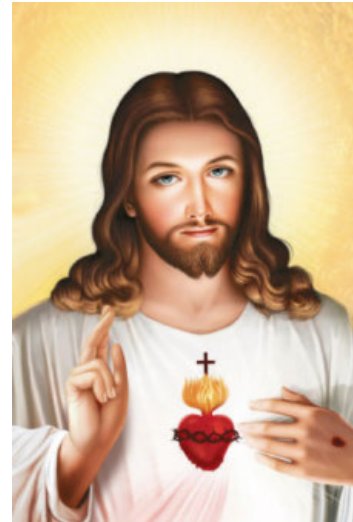


Each member serves a three year term. Members are required to attend a monthly meeting held on the second Tuesday of each month as well as volunteer to sell TRIP usually twice per quarter.

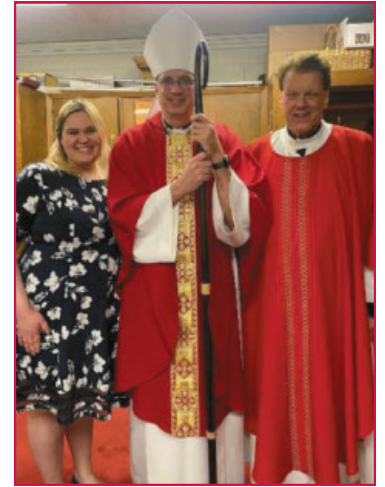

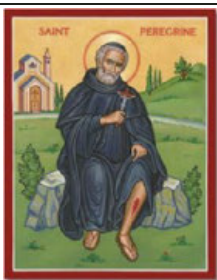


SCA SCHOOL NEWS

St. Peregrine is the patron saint for persons suffering from illnesses of all types in particular cancer. Saint Peregrine was healed of a cancerous ulcer on his leg which was considered beyond saving. The fame of this event in 1325 spread rapidly around the western Church.

Christians, and especially the sick, began to invoke his name and seek his intercession for the relief of their suffering and even for a cure from sickness. The canonization of St. Peregrine in 1726 increased people's devotion to him which spread to the universal Church.

St. Catherine of Alexandria will begin offering a Novena to St. Peregrine at 7:00p.m. in the church. The Novena will be held for 9 Mondays. All are welcome.

Rebecca Etelej, her husband Lotiang Ekutan and their family pose for a portrait in Turkana, Kenya. Rebecca and her husband Lotiang farmed and raised livestock for several years, but more frequent and severe droughts attributed to climate change have made farming difficult. Through a CRS program—in collaboration with the diocese of Lodwar in Kenya—a new well equipped with a solar plumbing unit was constructed in Rebecca and Lotiang's village. They can now access water to irrigate their fields and take care of their goats. They also learned new farming techniques through the program, such as how to grow kale, which they use to feed their family and sell at the market. Rebecca and Lotiang share what they have learned with others in their community so everyone can benefit.

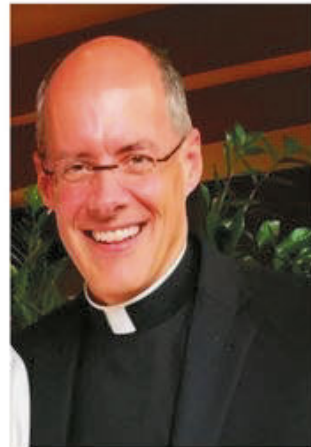

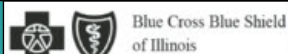
