My Dear People of St. Catherine,

Congratulations to our First Communicants who just made their First Holy Communion this Saturday. The 2nd grade school teachers, Ms. Kirsten Hess and Ms. Jennifer Wilson, and 2nd grade Religious Education catechist, Ms. Anna Lowery, prepared our children well. I am grateful them and also to Ms. Theresa Ward, our Coordinator of Family Faith Formation, for helping our students get ready for their First Holy Communion. The children were so eager to receive our Lord for the first time. Our children, with reverent and joyous smiles, are a reminder to all of us just how special the Eucharist is. Simple gifts of bread and wine become the extraordinary gift of Jesus himself. Though routine can become a part of life, we should never receive Holy Communion routinely. The Eucharist is a great mystery of our faith, that Jesus is truly present in the form of bread and wine. Fr. Fred and I visited with our children to also help them prepare for their First Holy Communion. For me, it is always a special time to talk with our students about the importance of Jesus giving the gift of himself in the Eucharist. As I do every year, I took our students on a tour of our church. I explained to them about the importance of the Tabernacle. I pointed out the statues and pictures in church, and we talked about the Holy Family, St. Catherine of Alexandria, Mary of Perpetual Help, Our Lady of Guadalupe, and the Stations of the Cross. I took them into the priest's sacristy and showed them the various vestments the priests wear. They marveled at the gold plated chalices, which hold the Precious Blood of our Lord.

Last Sunday, April 23, a dear priest whom I knew well, Monsignor Mike Adams, was called home to the Lord, at the blessed age of 90. Fr. Mike was my first pastor. I was ordained on May 10, 1978, and my first assignment was St. Gall on 55th and Kedzie in Chicago. A priest's first parish is very special, not to say that all assignments are not special. Fr. Mike was a good mentor for me as a and was instrumental in giving me a very good and positive experience as a parish priest. Our small parish staff worked together well as a team, and Fr. Mike helped make this happen. It was last Saturday afternoon that I received the news that he had taken seriously sick. I quickly went to visit him at Little Company of Mary Hospital. He seemed to be resting peacefully, though not very responsive. I took his hand and prayed at his bedside. I prayed out loud so he could hear me; the Daytime Prayer of the Liturgy of the Hours and then the Rosary. I then Anointed him. Many good memories flashed through my mind as tears streamed down my face. Visitation was Friday at Christ the King, where he lived for nearly 20 years after his retirement. I was honored to pray his Wake Service on Friday evening and concelebrate his Funeral Mass this Saturday. Fr. Mike was ordained in 1959, which means Fr. Mike was a priest for the Archdiocese of Chicago for nearly 64 years. As some of you might remember, Fr. Mike (he wasn't much into the title of Monsignor) came here as administrator, shortly after the sudden death of Fr. Pat Henry. I remember the day I arrived as your new pastor on September 1, 2013. He greeted me, dropped the church keys in my hand, and said, "It's all yours." **Eternal rest grant unto Fr. Mike, O Lord. May he rest in peace. Amen.**

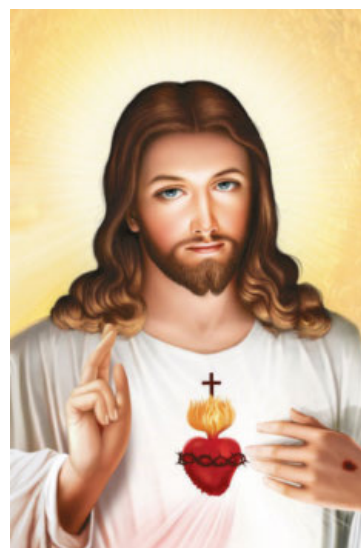


Catholic Charities Collection on Mother's Day

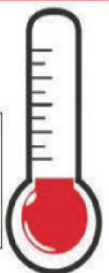

on his leg which was considered beyond saving. The fame of this event in 1325 spread rapidly around the western Church.

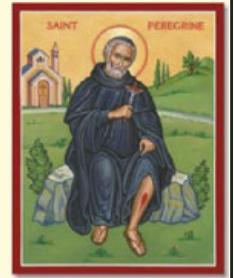
