



Second Collection - Catholic Charities
May 13 & 14

My Dear People of St. Catherine,

In our Catholic Tradition, the month of May is dedicated to Mary. A long, beautiful tradition of our Catholic Church is May Crowning, crowning Mary as "the Queen of the May," our Queen of Heaven and Earth. The Order of May Crowning Ritual states: "The queen symbol was attributed to Mary because she was a perfect follower of Christ, who is the absolute 'crown' of creation. She is the Mother of the Son of God, who is the messianic King. Mary is the Mother of Christ, the Word Incarnate... 'He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High... Elizabeth greeted the Blessed Virgin, pregnant with Jesus, as 'the mother of my Lord.' Mary is the perfect follower of Christ. The maid of Nazareth consented to God's plan; she journeyed on the pilgrimage of faith; she listened to God's Word and kept it in her heart; she remained steadfastly in close union with her Son, all the way to the foot of the Cross; she persevered in prayer with the Church. Thus, in an eminent way, she won the 'crown of righteousness,' 'the crown of life,' 'the crown of glory' that is promised to those who follow Christ."

So why crown Mary? In an online article Marge Fenelon of the National Catholic Reporter, wrote in her blog on May 1, 2016: *Not because it's a long-standing tradition in the Church, although it is. Not because there are any special graces connected to it, although there are. No, do it because Mary is Mother – your mother, my mother, everyone's mother – and because she cares for all of us day-in-and-day-out without fail, interceding for us in even the tiniest matters. For that, she deserves an entire month in her honor.*

Last Sunday, therefore, we crowned Mary at the 9:30 a.m. Mass. Our children who made their First Communion the day before processed to Mary and honored her by presenting to her blue carnations. Then Mary was crowned by two members of our 55+ club, Linda and Casey Kowalski.



St. Teresa of Calcutta said: "If you ever feel distressed during your day, call upon our Lady, just say this simple prayer: 'Mary, Mother of Jesus, please be a mother to me now.' I must admit, this prayer has never failed me."
