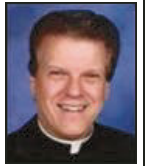

We remember our mothers this weekend in a variety of ways which show our love and gratitude to them for giving us life and nurturing us not only physically, but also in the ways of faith. May the Lord's blessing be especially bright upon mothers everywhere on this blessed Mother's Day. For them, I offer up the following prayer.



Prayer for Mothers: *Heavenly Father, from the beginning you have chosen to entrust the human person to mothers in a special way. We thank and praise you for the gift of mothers; for their tenderness, care, and compassion, for their intuition and encouragement, as well as for their commitment and sacrifice. Bless all mothers this day. Keep, strengthen, and refresh them in your loving care. May they be blessed by our open-hearted love and gratitude. Amen.*

On Mother's Day you once again have the opportunity to remember your Mothers, Grandmothers, Godmothers, and Mother Figures, both living and deceased, in special Masses which will be offered up monthly. Our parish honored Mary, the Mystical Rose, with a school May Crowning on Friday, May 12. The Mary statue in our Mary Garden was crowned. Two of our 8th grade students crowned Mary. Nora G and Gabe J were selected to crown Mary by their classmates for being great examples of living out our Christian calling.

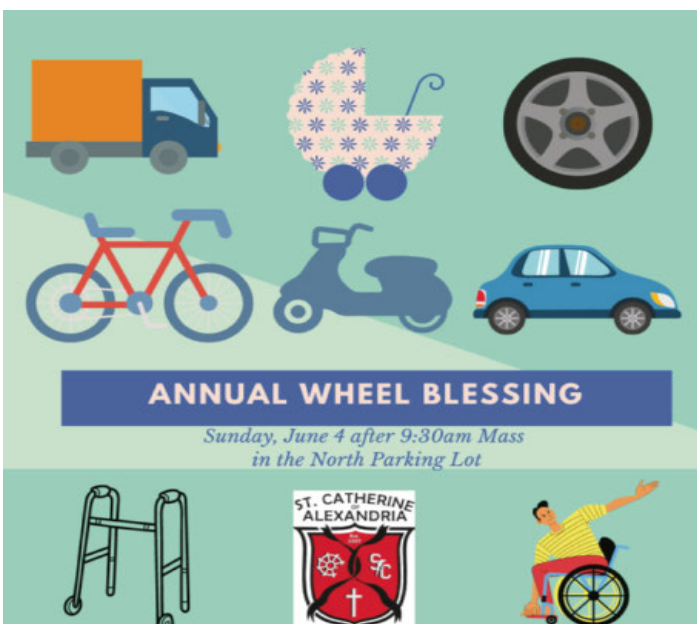
