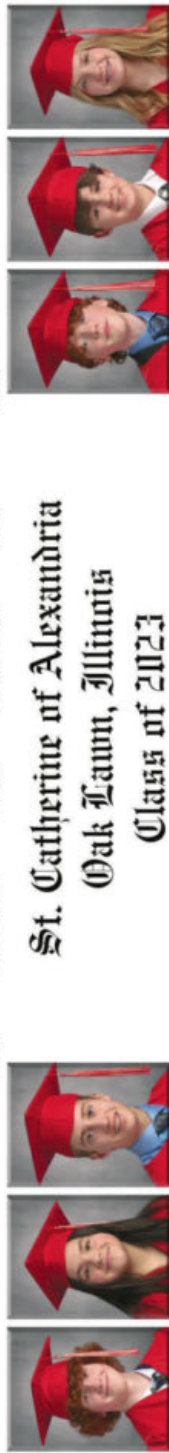

Last Sunday, we celebrated the feast of the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ into heaven. Now this weekend, 50 Days after Easter, we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, the celebration of the gift of the Holy Spirit to the disciples, to the Church and to us. Last week, Ascension Sunday, we heard Jesus assuring his disciples that, "you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem" (Acts 1:8). Today's first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, the evangelist, Luke, writes about descent of the Holy Spirit onto the apostles using very vivid images. "There appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them." (Acts 2:3). "And they were filled with the Holy Spirit". The Apostles began speaking in multiple languages to the many diverse people which had gathered in Jerusalem for the Jewish feast of Shavuot, a harvest festival, about "the mighty acts of God." We hear in John today (John 15:26-27: 16:12-15) about the Holy Spirit as the Advocate. In Greek, the word is parakletōs, which has a variety of meanings: advocate, mediator, counselor, and comforter. It is the Holy Spirit which guides the Church in its mission. It was on Pentecost that the Holy Spirit formed the Church. Today is the birthday of the Church, and we welcome everyone who has come to celebrate this feast and pray with us. **HAPPY BIRTHDAY!**

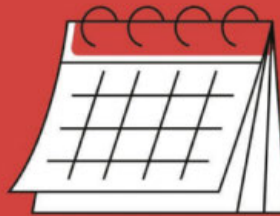

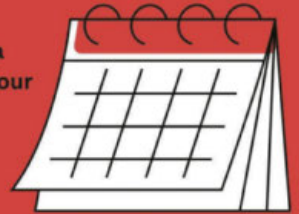

The intent is to avoid significant conflicts whether taking place on or off our parish campus. Plus, the parish office needs to know what events are happening when questions come in.

Finally, as events are scheduled and reviewed, be sensitive to your fundraising. St. Catherine parishioners are very generous as well as our local businesses. Please be respectful with your requests. We have a very active parish which is a great tribute to our parishioners. I appreciate all that you do for our parish and school.
