



My Dear People of St. Catherine,

As the Easter season draws to a close and Ordinary Time begins, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity this weekend. Today we celebrate the mystery of our God revealed to us as three persons, one in being, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Father is God; the Son is God; the Holy Spirit

is God. Yet, there are not three Gods but one eternal God.

Next weekend is the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ.

After the 9:30am Mass, we will have an outside Procession of the Blessed Sacrament. The Eucharist is exposed not just to the

faithful inside the Church, but to all the world outside.

We are looking forward to our carnival, and we want everyone to have a safe and fun time. Our carnival co-chairs have been in constant contact with our Oak Lawn police department. We have increased our security measures for this year. There will be a fence around the perimeter of the carnival, allowing entrance only through the gates. We will have additional off-duty police officers at the carnival, along with additional parishioners plainly identified as security. After 8:00pm, those under 18 will only be admitted with a parent. Our Oak Lawn police have been monitoring social media and will be vigilant in patrolling our village. Our carnival committee and volunteers have been working very hard preparing for our 39th carnival. Finally, let us all pray good weather and a fun time for everyone.

Our Class of 2023 graduated this past Friday. We are proud of their accomplishments and congratulate them, and we wish them well as they look forward to high school. Our last day of school is this Tuesday. I would like to personally thank all our teachers and staff, our principal, Ms. Kristine Owens, and assistant principal, Mrs. Sue Kehoe, for their loving dedication in teaching our students and passing on the faith. I also thank our school parents for the sacrifices they have made to send their sons and daughters to our school, and their commitment to Catholic Education. We end our school year with nearly 500 students in our school. I also thank our catechists in Religious Education and our Coordinator of Family Faith Formation, Ms. Theresa Ward, for their commitment in sharing their faith with our children. I wish all our school and religious education families a great summer.

During the month of May, our school had two other graduations. Our 7th grade students graduated from D.A.R.E., Drug Abuse Resistance Education on May 1. They joined millions of D.A.R.E. students who have learned good decision making skills to help them lead safe and healthy lives free from bullying, alcohol, substance abuse, and other dangerous behaviors. Our 6th graders graduated from the EDGE, Education for Gang Evasion, on May 30th. They joined over 18,000 students who have learned that the gang life style is something they have been shown to avoid by making smart decisions for themselves. We thank our Oak Lawn Police Department and Chief Daniel Vittorio for offering these programs to our students.

This weekend, we welcome Fr. Chuck Dahm, O.P., who is the Director of the Archdiocese of Chicago Domestic Violence Outreach. Their work is guided by the pastoral letter of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (2002). In it they write: "We state as clearly and strongly as we can, that violence against women, inside or outside the home, is never justified."

Trinity Sunday | June 4, 2023

Trinity Sunday celebrates the mystery of the Triune God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—that Saint Paul names in today's second reading. That same Triune God is proclaimed in the Gospel's description of the saving mission of the Son, sent by the Father, in the power of the Holy Spirit.

Trinity Sunday also celebrates the mystery of the Church that draws her life and her mission from the Most Holy Trinity. So, for example, the Second Vatican Council quoting Saint Cyprian says: "Hence the universal Church is seen to be 'a people brought into unity from the unity of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit." (Lumen gentium, 4) Then, there is the extraordinary and striking description of our life in the Church in Gaudium et spes (Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World): "...the Lord Jesus, when praying to the Father 'that they may all be one ... even as we are one,' has opened up new horizons closed to human reason by implying that there is a certain parallel between the union existing among the divine persons and the union of the sons and daughters of God in truth and love." (Gaudium et spes, 24)

The mystery of God and the mystery of the Church come together for us every time we celebrate the Eucharist. Our worship is directed to the Father through his son Jesus and in the Holy Spirit. We join ourselves to the self-sacrificing love and self-gift of Jesus offered to the Father as his supreme act of worship in the power of the Holy Spirit. That is the heart of our full, active, and conscious participation in the Mass.

If we listen and join ourselves to the words of the liturgy, we will truly know that our worship as God's very own people is directed to the Father through Jesus in the Holy Spirit. Every celebration of the Eucharist is a fresh encounter with the Holy Trinity. Listen to these words from the Third Eucharistic Prayer:

You are indeed holy, O Lord, and all you have created rightly gives you praise, for through your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, by the power and working of the Holy Spirit, you give life to all things and make them holy, and you never cease to gather a people to yourself, so that from the rising of the sun to its setting a pure sacrifice may be offered to your name.


