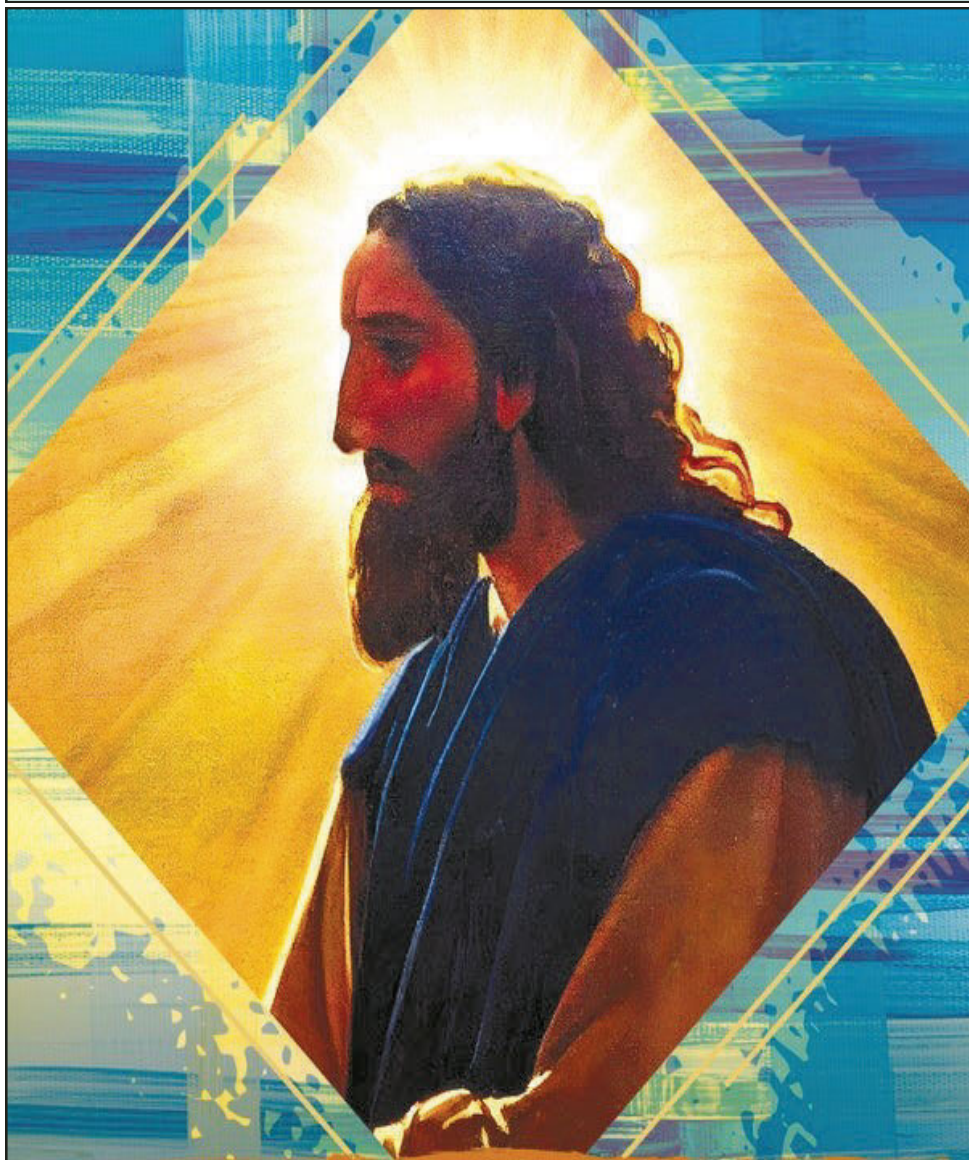

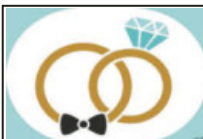

Summer on the Mount



Dear Friends,

The story is told of a university student who came home for the summer vacation. During that time, he met with his pastor and announced, "I've decided that I don't need the Church anymore. All I need to live a good life is to follow the Sermon on the Mount."

In case you don't remember, the Sermon on the Mount can be found in chapters five through seven of St. Matthew's Gospel, and it contains some startling utterances by Jesus:

Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you (falsely) because of me... But I say to you, offer no resistance to one who is evil... But I say to you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you... So be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect... If you forgive others their transgressions, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your transgressions... You cannot serve God and mammon... Do not worry about tomorrow; tomorrow will take care of itself... Stop judging, that you may not be judged... Do to others whatever you would have them do to you.

You get the idea. These statements are so familiar to us they may have lost some of their punch, but when we really pay attention to them, we can't help but realize this is strong stuff.

That student's goal was probably to shock the priest and at the same time justify why he didn't bother coming to Mass Sunday mornings. Certainly, he expected some sort of sad rejoinder on why he shouldn't give up on the Church, because it's a useful institution in society, and so on.

Instead, he himself received a surprise when his priest exclaimed, "Great! I'm thrilled you're living by the Sermon on the Mount." A momentary pause: "How are you doing with that?"

After he left the appointment, that question, "How are you doing with the Sermon on the Mount?" kept reverberating in the student's mind, no matter how hard he tried to escape it. Eventually, it pulled him back to the Church.

He discovered, when he was honest with himself, he couldn't live a good life on his own. The REALITY of human weakness and sin pulled him down, so he needed the Sacrament of Reconciliation to provide God's forgiveness. He needed the grace he received from THE EUCHARIST to give him strength STRIVING to live a Christian life. He found that hearing the Scriptures read at Mass and discussed in a small group helped him understand what God wants from us; and the encouragement of others in that group supported him when he was tempted to give up.

You know, God created humans to be social creatures. Although the Church is so much more, one aspect of it is a social support network. Simply put, we need other Christians to help us stay close to God.

But it's also true that we can't be part of the Church only to receive grace and support. To have a healthy spiritual life we also have to give. Jesus Himself said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35).

And that's why we stress Discipleship of time, talent, and treasure. From a human standpoint, if everyone just took from the Church without giving anything back, the Church would soon disappear. But when we make commitments to SHARE our time in worship and prayer, our talent (whatever it may be) in service, and our treasure to extend God's kingdom, we find that we are enriched.

This summer, take a little time to check how well you're doing with the Sermon on the Mount. Then, check out the Church to see how participating in her life strengthens your life. You'll be amazed at the spiritual life flowing through her.

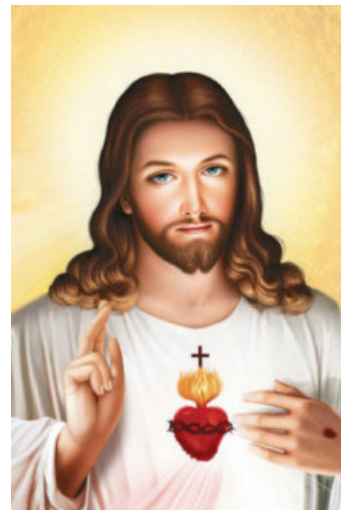

Second Collection—July 1 & 2

When Russia invaded Ukraine in February 2022, a humanitarian crisis began for Ukrainians, whose lives were shattered by the violence of war. Many left their homes in eastern cities in Ukraine for cities in the west, such as Lviv, farther from the most intense fighting. From the beginning of the war, the Holy Father pleaded for an end to the violence and expressed his love and concern for the Ukrainian people who were its victims. In solidarity with the victims of war, the papal almoner, Cardinal Konrad Krajewski, made two visits to Ukraine in March 2022. He first visited the cities of Rivne and Zhovka and other regions directly affected by the early conflict. He returned to Ukraine to celebrate Mass in the cathedral in Lviv and to deliver an ambulance donated by the Holy Father to the Center for Mother and Child Health to assist children displaced by the war.

The Holy Father's charitable outreach to victims of war, migrants and refugees, and the poor affected by illness and natural disasters is supported by contributions to the Peter's Pence Collection. When you participate in the collection, you join Catholics across the globe in supporting the pope's mission of mercy as well as the activities of the Holy See's dicasteries that assist his ministry.

Support for such papal efforts is rooted in the scriptural message to take care of the poor and expresses unity with

the Holy Father in two ways: through the ongoing activities of the Holy See and through the charitable works of the Holy Father on behalf of those most in need.
