



# Celebrating the Month of July Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

There are many blessings bestowed upon us as a free nation. July is traditionally the month we celebrate our independence. We fly our American flags and celebrate with colorful fireworks provided us by our villages, neighborhood parks and forest preserves. We host picnics in our back yards with family, friends, and neighbors. We wear patriotic t-shirts. There are many ways we honor the birth of our country. And one of the best things we can do as we celebrated Independence Day this past Tuesday was to say a prayer of thanks to our forefathers who first came here in search of freedom and independence. These are the same people who defended our country when its freedom was threatened and still do so today.

Several years ago I became interested in genealogy. I have often wondered what it was like for my ancestors as they made their way to America in search of a better way of life; a life of freedom and independence. My great, great grandfather, John Murphy (a cooper) escaped the potato famine in Ireland in the year 1848. He landed in New York where he married Mary Dooly. They eventually landed in Chesterton, Indiana looking for freedom and a better way of life. Their home from 1852 is still standing and presently a museum in the town of Chesterton, Indiana (John & Mary where one of the founding families).

My great grandmother, Augusta Meithe came to America and eventually landed in Blue Island where her sister Christine had settled; both were looking for a better life than they had in Saxony, Germany.

The same was true for the Dolehide family, Michael and Katherine, my mother's grandparents who also escaped Ireland because of the potato famine. My research made me realize how much families sacrificed to make the American dream a reality.

On the Czech side... my father's mother, Louise (Kalina) Pesek, came through the gates of Ellis Island in 1904 with her sister Bess and parents, Joseph and Emma. Emma's brother, Bohumil, was a butcher in Chicago; it was he who made room in his home so that they could get a fresh start in the new country.

My grandfather, Laddie Pesek, his brother Frank, sister Anna and his parents, Frank and Anna, came here on July 4, 1900. They also entered through the new port of Ellis Island looking for a fresh start. My grandfather (6 years old) told us that he cried when he saw the Statue of Liberty. I have loved learning the stories of my ancestors. It was humbling to learn how my relatives took the risk of crossing an ocean to seek a better way of life, a life we often take for granted. I know what my grandfather was thinking when he first got a glimpse of the Statue of Liberty after being on a ship for almost three weeks. This is the statue that represents our independence and all the freedom that we enjoy through the sacrifices of our ancestors.

I would venture to say that many of you reading this column are descendants of those who immigrated here because they believed there was a better life waiting for them and they were willing to take the risk and make the sacrifices. It is because of their sacrifices that we are a blessed with the freedom that we enjoy today. Let us be thankful for these blessings.

Discipleship teaches us to acknowledge what we have in life and to share with others less fortunate. As God sacrificed his only begotten Son to die for our sins, discipleship living a stewardship way of life calls us to be better sharers of the resources that have been entrusted to our care.

Just a few days ago we celebrated America's "247 years" of independence, let us give thanks for our blessings. God Bless America today, tomorrow and always.


Ignatian Volunteer Corps Information Session





The only requirement is that you pray the rosary each day.











