

Over the years I have wasted a lot: a lot of money, a lot of time, and a lot of talent. Sometimes I didn't realize I was wasting these things but, after reflection, I realized I could have done more and accomplished much greater things. Of course, I think that is part of our imperfect humanity. It truly is easier for us to waste our gifts than grow them into something more.

The parable of the sower speaks about the word of God that gets planted in our hearts. If the soil of our heart is rich, then the word will grow and change us. If that soil is rocky or full of weeds, the word will lie there without any impact, bearing no fruit.

This parable can be applied to living a stewardship way of life as well. As sowers, we have been given the seeds of our time, talent, and treasure. We have a choice of where to plant these gifts. As good everyday stewards, we are called to plant them wisely and prudently. Oftentimes it is not enough to simply give away what we have. We need to discern the best places to sow these gifts so the maximum harvest can grow. This takes prayer, reflection, and study. Without a solid discernment process, we can find ourselves sowing seeds endlessly without much to show for it. But joyful is the person who has used one's gifts wisely, for the bounty of the harvest is great.

2023 Mission Appeal

The Catholic faith continues to spread in leaps and bounds in the Diocese of Soroti. In 2019 alone, there were 31,309 Infant Baptisms. Every single Church parish in the entire Diocese is filled beyond capacity at its principal Sunday liturgies with a significant number of people standing outside the Church.

After over 5 years without a Bishop, Pope Francis in March 2019 appointed Bishop Joseph Eciru Oliach to lead and shepherd the people of God in the Diocese. After his episcopal ordination in May 2019, he had 22,600 Confirmations between June and December of 2019 alone! In addition nineteen young men have been ordained in the last two and a half years.

To meet the overwhelming need for pastoral services, the new bishop created 15 new parishes in the summer of 2019 and additional 8 since then (23 new parishes in 3 years!). These were created by breaking up the largest of the existing 26 parishes. In essence, the

number of parishes almost doubled! These new parishes are in dire need for buildings and other facilities (churches, rectories, halls and other health/social/educational amenities).

The proceeds from this mission appeal will therefore be applied towards facilitating the development of these new parishes. The funds will especially be dedicated to the procurement of manufactured and/or imported building products (cement, iron bars, roofing metals, iron sheets and paint) to enable the construction of buildings in the new parishes.

In addition, most of these parishes are located in rural areas with no grid electricity and piped water systems. The proceeds will also be applied to securing solar electricity systems and water units: water wells/water boreholes/rain water harvesters

MISSION COOPERATION PLAN 2023 Mission Appeals

Every year, as part of the Mission Cooperation Plan, every parish in the Archdiocese of Chicago gets to host a group from the missions. The purpose of this program is twofold; first a reminder that we are a universal body of Christ, the Church. Secondly, is to provide an opportunity to support the spread of the gospel and to meet the needs of our brothers and sisters in the mission countries. This year, **Sacred Heart Church** shall have the **Diocese of Soroti, Uganda** next weekend June 22-23, 2023. Fr. Geoffrey Akiso Odong, from Uganda will be visiting us. Here is a brief background of the Diocese of Soroti.

The Diocese of Soroti located in Eastern Uganda was erected by Pope St. John Paul II on the 29th November 1980. It geographically covers the ten civil districts of the Teso Sub-region and a land area of 33,130 sq.km (20,586 sq.miles). The total population of the area covered is 3.5 million people and the Catholic population is 1.7 million people representing about 45%.

At its founding, the diocese was staffed mostly by priests from the Mill Hill Missionary Society (*some of whom were from the United States*) as there were few native priests. In the course of the years, native vocations were nurtured and blossomed so much so that today a great majority of the 68 priests are natives and there are more than 50 Seminarians at different levels of Major Seminary formation.

Soon after its creation, the North and Eastern regions of Uganda (*including the entire area covered by the Diocese of Soroti*) was plunged into a civil war, which lasted almost two decades and left the population devastated economically and socially. The people who survived this turmoil were sustained by their faith which by the grace of God was strengthened and grew in the midst of the turmoil. And now just like the rest of the world, they suffered and are recovering from the effects of Covid-19. For more information you can visit www.soroticatholicdiocese.org.


