My Dear People of St. Catherine,

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration. It is one of the great feasts of our Church. It always is celebrated on August 6. When if falls on a Sunday, it takes the place of the regular Sunday readings. The Transfiguration is one of the key events in the earthly life of Jesus, where he revealed his divinity to three of his closest disciples by means of a miraculous and supernatural light. Prior to the Transfiguration, Jesus had spoke to his disciples that He would suffer and die after entering Jerusalem before his Resurrection. So before his triumphal entry into Jerusalem, Jesus took three apostles (Peter, James and John) up to the high mountain of Mount Tabor to pray. As they were praying, the clothes of Jesus became "dazzling white." At that point, the Old Testament figures of Moses (representing the Law of the Old Testament) and Elijah (representing the Prophets) appeared and spoke with them. Peter wanted to put up three tents, which represented the forty years the people of Israel spent in the wilderness living in temporary dwellings. A cloud came over those gathered, and God the Father's voice, speaking from the cloud, said, "This is my Son, my Chosen: listen to Him." The divine glory of Jesus shined through His human body. The apostles, Peter, James and John experienced and contemplated for a short time the eternal joy of Jesus, in the view of His upcoming Passion and Crucifixion. God is light, and Jesus wishes his closest friends to experience this light dwelling

The Transfiguration strengthened the faith of his disciples and reinforced that the teachings of Jesus foretelling his suffering and death would definitely take place. The Transfiguration is also shared today to strengthen our faith as we bear our crosses, with the unwavering hope that we too will share in his glorious victory for all eternity.

#### St. Pope John Paul II said:

We, pilgrims on earth, are granted to rejoice in the company of the transfigured Lord when we immerse ourselves in the things of above through prayer and the celebration of the divine mysteries. But, like the disciples, we too must descend from Tabor into daily life where human events challenge our faith. On the mountain we saw; on the paths of life we are asked tirelessly to proclaim the Gospel which illuminates the steps of believers.

#### Likewise, Pope Francis said:

From the event of the Transfiguration I would like to take two significant elements that can be summed up in two words: ascent and descent. We all need to go apart, to ascend the mountain in a space of silence, to find ourselves and better perceive the voice of the Lord. This we do in prayer. But we cannot stay there! Encounter with God in prayer inspires us anew to "descend the mountain" and return to the plain where we meet many brothers weighed down by fatigue, sickness, injustice, ignorance, poverty both material and spiritual. To these brothers in difficulty, we are called to bear the fruit of that experience with God, by sharing the grace we have received.

#### A Transfiguration Prayer

My transfigured Lord, You promise suffering and death to all who follow You, but You also promise the hope that awaits those who endure. Grant me the grace to endure every cross in life, uniting my sufferings with Yours, so that I may one day partake in the glory of eternal life in Heaven. Jesus, I trust in You.

Phil then presented this code and the "parishioner" used this code to get into Phil's Facebook account. It was later found out that this "parishioner" had been hacked and the hacker tricked Phil into "helping". Please be vigilant when responding to Facebook messages asking for help, links that might be sent, or messages that seem suspicious. When in doubt, contact the person directly via a different method. Hackers are using these accounts to hack more people using the same methods. They are also using these accounts by pretending to be the person whose account they are using and claiming that they are selling various items. There are no real items for sale and it is a scam. Always double check sources prior to sending money or information.


#### Direction For Our Times Lay Apostles of the Returning King (ARK)
