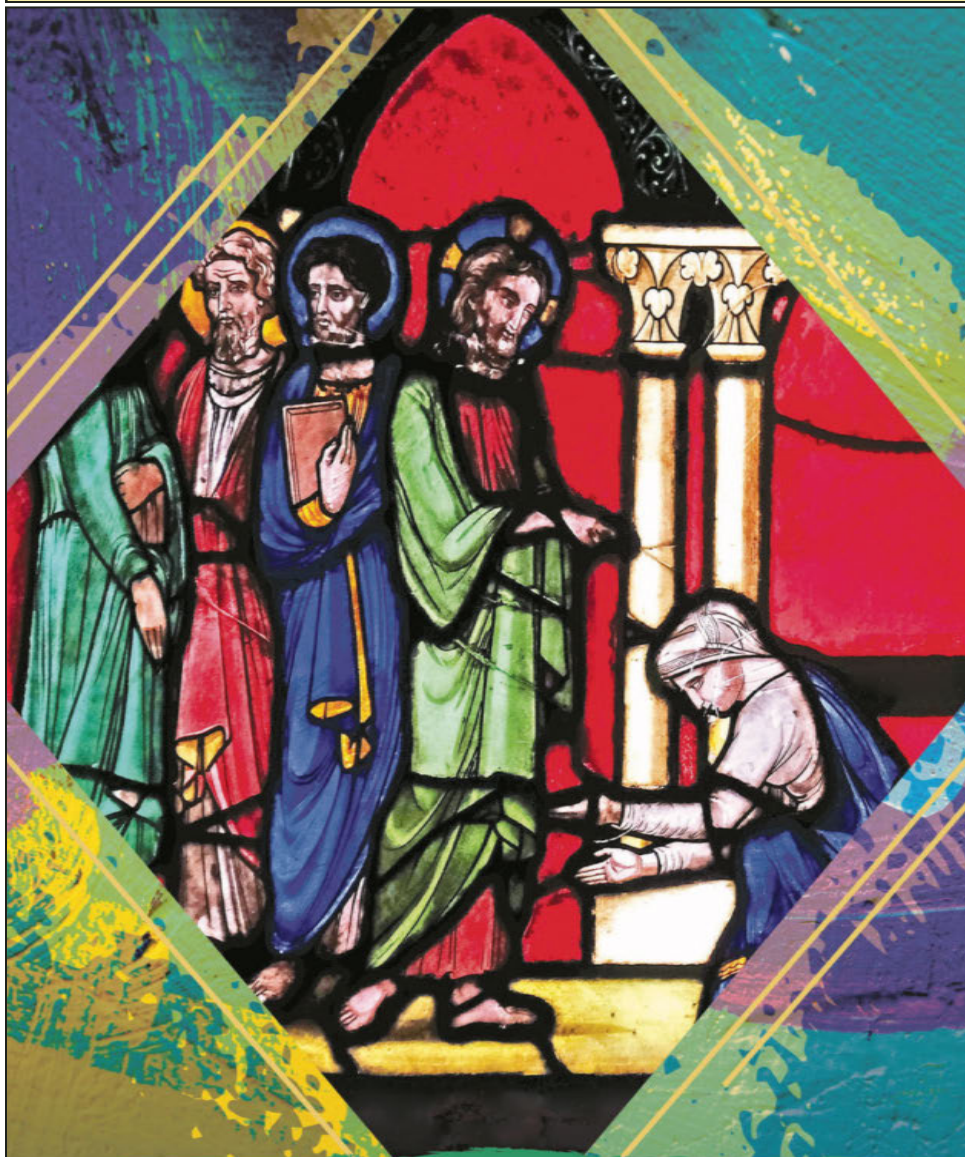

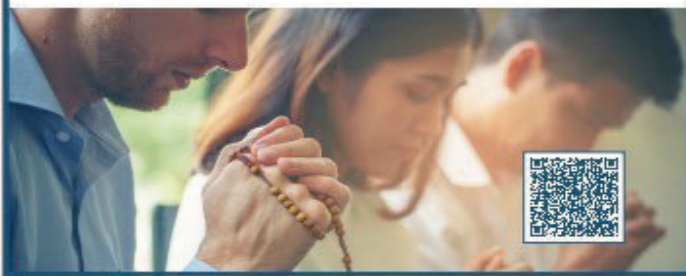

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

This past Tuesday August 15th we celebrated The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The Natale of Dormittio (falling asleep) of Mary came to be celebrated as early as the 5th century in the East and in Rome; patroness of France, Paraguay, Jamaica, South Africa, and New Caledonia.

On this Holy Day of obligation, one of the options for the readings is Revelation 11:19 and flows into Chapter 12:1-6. In this passage, we are reminded of the themes of good versus evil. It brings home the point that good will overcome evil. Through the intercession of Mary bearing the word made flesh in (Jesus). The virgin mother, Mary, unselfishly embraced God's plan for her in salvation history. We need to aspire to be like Mary in saying "Yes" to the gift of discipleship in living out a stewardship way of life. As we hear the scriptures proclaimed Sunday after Sunday, we hear of those like Mary who said "Yes" Lord I am your faithful servant. Please meditate upon the canticle of Mary in Luke Chapter 1:46-56. Discipleship is about service in the name of Jesus. As we reflect upon our lives are we a people of service or to be served? If we strive to be a people of service then the focus is to embrace our neighbor in building the Kingdom.

And Mary said: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my Savior. For he has looked upon his handmaid's lowliness; behold, from now on all ages will call me blessed. The Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name. His mercy is from age to age to those who fear him. He has shown might with his arm, dispersed the arrogant of mind and heart. He has thrown down the rulers from their thrones but lifted up the lowly. The hungry he has filled with good things; the rich he has sent away empty. He has helped Israel his servant, remembering his mercy, according to his promise to our fathers, to Abraham and to his descendants forever." Mary remained with her cousin Elizabeth about three months and then returned to her home.

After praying, the Canticle of Mary begs the question how do we praise the Lord as his disciples?

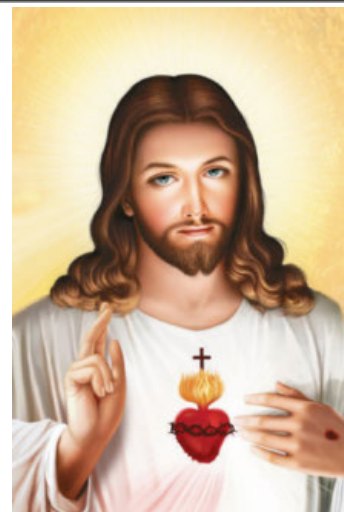
How it happened:

Phil received a message via Facebook Messenger from a parishioner. This "parishioner" was asking Phil for assistance with getting back into their Facebook account. The "parishioner" then stated that Facebook was going to text Phil a code to help them get into their account. Phil then presented this code and the "parishioner" used this code to get into Phil's Facebook account. It was later found out that this "parishioner" had been hacked and the hacker tricked Phil into "helping". Please be vigilant when responding to Facebook messages asking for help, links that might be sent, or messages that seem suspicious. When in doubt, contact the person directly via a different method. Hackers are using these accounts to hack more people using the same methods. They are also using these accounts by pretending to be the person whose account they are using and claiming that they are selling various items. There are no real items for sale and it is a scam. Always double check sources prior to sending money or information.

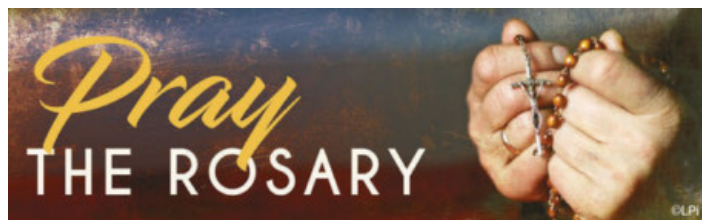

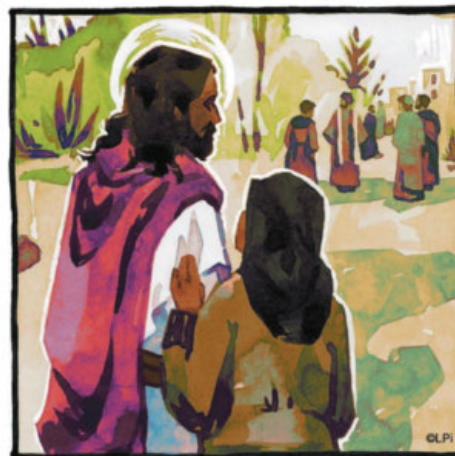
