Welcome Mrs. Sandra Bustamante! Coordinator of Family Faith Formation

To the community of St. Catherine of Alexandria:

I would like to introduce myself to all of you. My name is Sandra Bustamante, and through this article you will find a small biography of who I am. I was born in Lima, Peru, and when I reached the age of traveling, I moved to Munich, Germany where I spent several years with my sisters. My Dad has passed away, and my mother still lives in Lima, Peru. I come from a big family and I am the youngest of eight siblings. I am married and we have a 10-year-old son.

My ministry in Catechesis started when I was very young. I loved to attend Sunday School and was very involved in Confirmation classes/retreats. I have always been in touch with parish life. When I came to the United States, I joined the community of St. Stanislaus Bishop and Martyr, in Posen, in Vicariate VI. I started my studies to become a Catechetical Leader. The deanery team nurtured me in the different ministries a parish has, for what I am truly grateful. I have worked at Blessed Sacrament Parish in Chicago, and lately at All Souls Parish in Lansing as Coordinator for Religious Education and Pastoral Associate. I worked to develop faith formation opportunities for both youth and adults through classes, retreats, and conferences. I am convinced of the importance of religious education in shaping and forming individuals, families, and our culture.

Being a part of St. Catherine of Alexandria parish is very exciting for me. I personally believe that God already has a plan for each of us and that no matter where we go, God is always showing us which path to follow. I am grateful to Fr. Dennis for the opportunity he has given to me and I am happy to join the community of faith here.

I kindly ask for your understanding, patience, and prayers during this period as I settle in and get to know all of you and the parish.

My Dear People of St. Catherine,

I have been following the visit of our Holy Father, Pope Francis, to World Youth Day 2023, which took place in Lisbon, Portugal, from August 1-6. Pope Francis celebrated the concluding Mass on August 6, with an estimated 1.5 million young



people, ages 18-35, in attendance. Pope John Paul II established World Youth Day in 1986, first held in Rome.

"It is the gathering of young people, from all over the world with the Pope. It is also a pilgrimage, a celebration of youth, an expression of the universal Church and an intense moment of evangelization for the youth world. ... It aims to provide all participants with a universal Church experience, fostering a personal encounter with Jesus Christ." <https://www.lisboa2023.org/en/what-is-it>

During those 6 days in August, Pope Francis delivered homilies, greetings, and blessings to the "sea of young people." Here are 10 take away quotes from our Holy Father as listed at <https://www.lisboa2023.org/>

- 1 "Have the courage, then, to replace your doubts with dreams. Replace your doubts with dreams: do not remain hostage to your fears, but set about working to realize your goals!"
- 2 "In the Church there is room for everyone. "Father, but I am a wretch, is there room for me? There is room for everyone! All together now, everyone, repeat with me in your own language: Everyone, everyone, everyone."
- 3 "Dear friends, if God calls you by name, it means that for God none of us is a number, but a face and a heart."
- 4 "This is the starting point of World Youth Day, but above all it is the starting point of our lives. Young men and women, we are loved the way we are, without makeup."
- 5 "That is the only time, the only time that we are allowed to look down upon others, when we are offering to help them up."
- 6 "Mary's joy is twofold: she had just received the angel's message that she would welcome the Redeemer of the world, and she was also given the news that her cousin was pregnant. This is interesting: instead of thinking about herself, she thinks of the other. Why? Because joy is missionary, joy is not just for one person, it is for sharing something with others."
- 7 "Nothing is free in life, everything has to be paid for. Only one thing is free: the love of Jesus! So, with this free gift that we have – the love of Jesus – and with the desire to carry on the journey, let us walk in hope, let us be mindful of our roots, and move forwards, without fear."
- 8 "Yet, I would like to tell you that we do not radiate light by putting ourselves in the spotlight, for that type of light is blinding. No, we cannot illumine others by projecting a perfect, well-ordered. No, we radiate light – we shine – by welcoming Jesus into our hearts and learning to love as he does."
- 9 "Those who love do not stand idly by, but serve others. Those who love hasten to serve, hasten to dedicate themselves to the service of others."
- 10 "I want to tell you: carry on, keep riding the waves of love, of charity. Be 'surfers' of love!"

Labor Day was established as a yearly national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and well-being of our country. I invite you to begin the day with Mass at 9:00am to thank God for our gift of labor and to pray for those under and unemployed. On this Labor Day, I thank the many parishioners who joyfully and graciously labor in so many different ways for the good of St. Catherine.

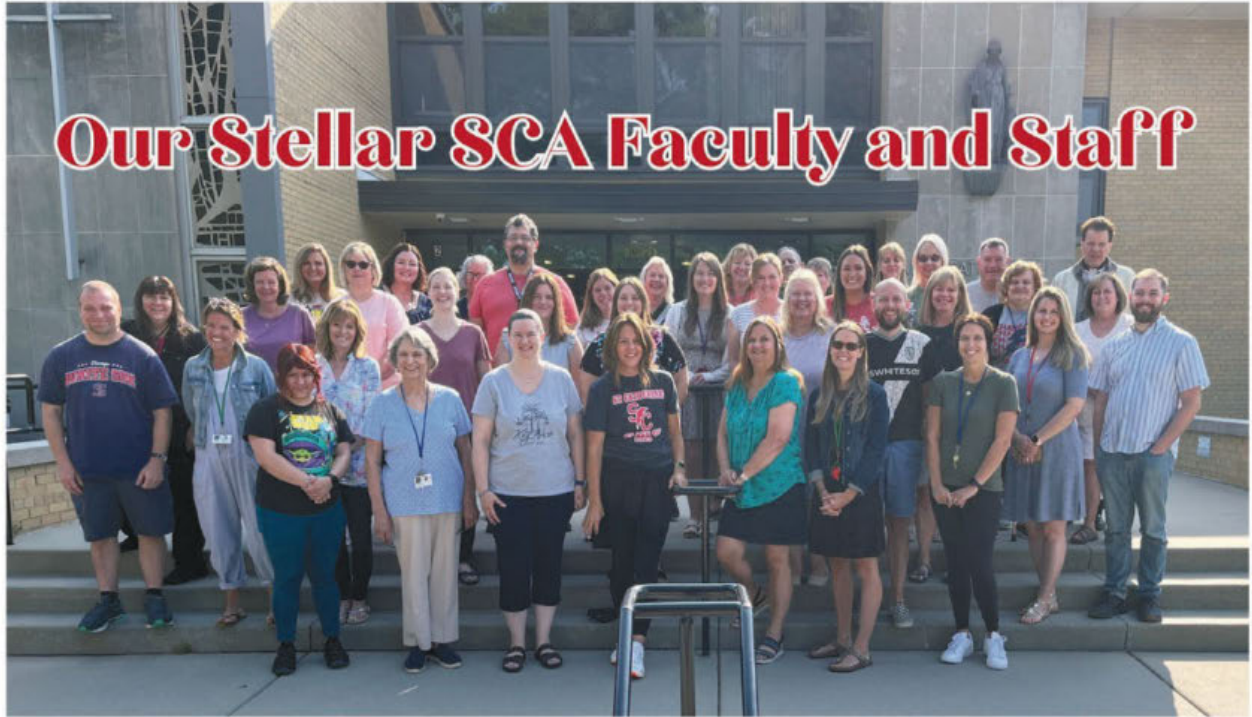

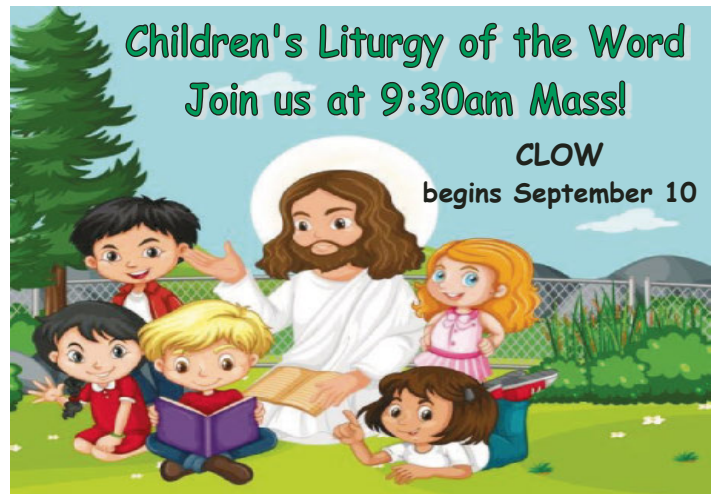
