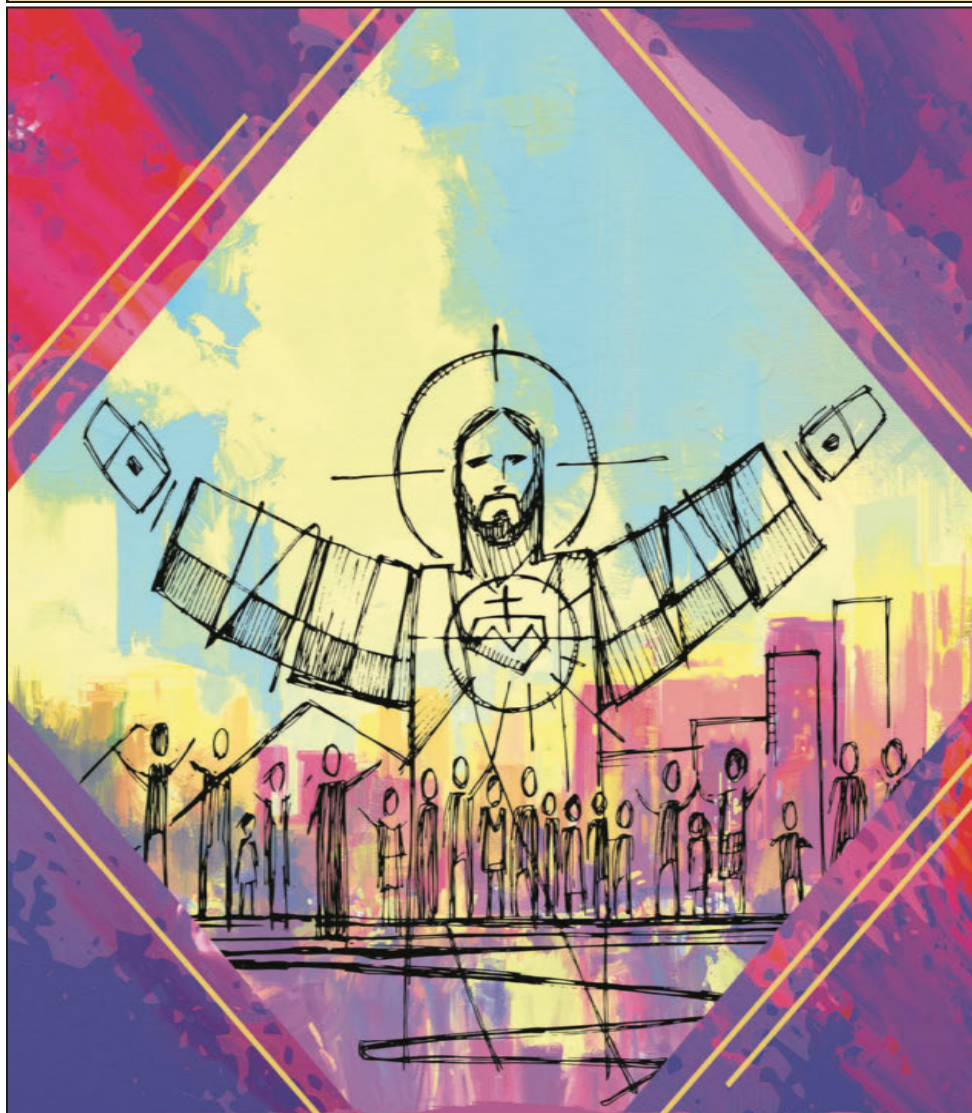

My Dear People of St. Catherine,

Thank you for taking the time this past Spring to complete the Disciple Maker Index Parish Survey. 267 parishioners, which accounts for about 37% of our parish October Count of 713 shared your input on a number of aspects of faith and community life here at St. Catherine of Alexandria Parish. As you will recall, the survey asked questions about each parishioner's own journey of discipleship and how the parish and the pastor are doing to support you along the way.

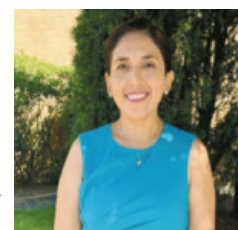


Our Parish Pastoral Council and Parish Staff and I will take the next few months to review and interpret the results and develop a report on what was collectively shared. Following that initial assessment, we will then identify actions to address specific areas of growth – whether it be across the parish or for me, personally, as your pastor.

I am grateful for everyone in our parish for what you have contributed through this survey. As a community of faith, may we use the results of this survey to grow closer to the Lord and to assist one another as brothers and sisters in Christ. I look forward to sharing more in the coming months as we continue renewing our Church and St. Catherine. Please take the time to read the insert in the bulletin, which has two of the multiple reports which can be generated. Some of the reports even allows comparisons to the national average of all parishes in the United States which have participated in this survey developed by the Catholic Leadership Institute.

Along with the Parish Survey, which all parishes of the Archdiocese participated in, every priest in the Archdiocese was also expected to participate in a more lengthy personal survey, which took me about an hour and a half to complete. Each priest was also asked to identify up to five associates, both priests and parishioners, to complete a short survey. I am grateful to those who participated for me, and these results will help me formulate a personal growth plan.

This Sunday, we welcome back all of our children, their parents, and their families who participate in our Religious Education Program. We welcome our new Coordinator of Family Faith Formation, Sandra Bustamante, who joins our parish team. She brings to St. Catherine a wealth of experience, a deep faith in the Lord, and a joyful enthusiasm. I am grateful to our Catechists who will be sharing their faith with our children, forming our children in the faith, preparing them for the celebration of the sacraments, and teaching them about Jesus.

After the Opening Prayer (Collect), children are invited forward to join one of our Catechists, and then they are sent forth by the presider.

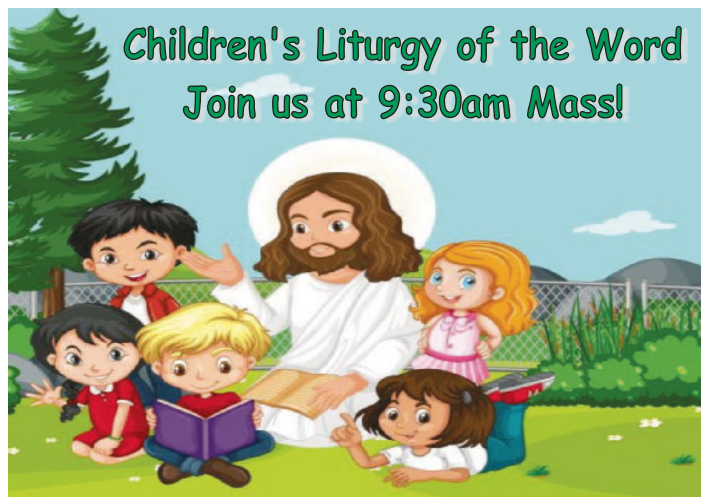



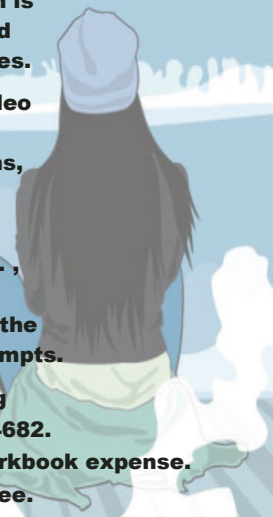
