



My Dear People of St. Catherine,

I thank Tim Glynn, a longtime parishioner of St. Catherine, for speaking at all Masses last weekend. He spoke eloquently and lovingly about his parish in terms of Faith, Family and Friends. He concluded by saying:

Saint Catherine is a community rooted in Faith, Family and Friendship, and we are responsive to the needs and the concerns of those around us. I believe we as a parish do this fairly well, living out our mission statement. But I also believe we could do a better job in the area of discipleship and evangelization, which I believe goes hand in hand with faith. I know I too need to work in



these areas if we are to remain a Vibrant Community of Faith. I believe that we need to invite people into this great faith community so that we can continue to grow and blossom so that we are always ready and able to answer God's call to spread His Good News and to help make new disciples. So I ask all of you, including myself, to extend an invitation to your neighbors, friends, co-workers to join us here at St Catherine, a parish that has been built on and is rooted in friend, family, and friendship, in a place I'm proud to call my home. Thank you.

For the next four weekends, starting October 7-8, the OCTOBER COUNT will take place at every parish. This count is used to measure a parish's vitality. Should a parish stand alone, or be merged with another? Does a parish have only one Pastor, or also an Associate? Is the parish growing, or has it stagnated? It's no secret that since COVID-19, our Mass attendance is down. In a conversation I had with a parishioner, the comment was made that you, Father, have this responsibility of bringing people to Church. As priest and pastor, I take this this responsibility very seriously. But I also responded that this is not only my responsibility, but also the calling of everyone who has been baptized in the Lord and practice their Faith. By our baptism, we have become Disciples of the Lord Jesus, living our faith seven days a week. But we also called to be Missionary Disciples, bringing others to experience Jesus in their lives.

SO I appeal to you, who are at Mass, to be a Missionary Disciple, and invite others to come to Mass this October. Share the Pack God's House bulletin insert with someone else who might be in need of the invitation.

Next Saturday, October 7, at 9:30am, in South Parking Lot, there will be a blessing of pets. This is a tradition in honor of St. Francis of Assisi (1186-1226), the patron saint of animals and ecology. His Feast Day is Wednesday, October 4. Pets of all types are welcome. Many pets are like family members. We thank and praise God for bringing them into our lives.

Last weekend, our school football program had Homecoming. It was most appropriate that the weekend began with the Saturday 4:00pm "Homecoming Mass" with players, poms, coaches, and parents coming together in prayer and receiving a special blessing. God's House was packed. The games took place on Sunday and the Pee-Wee, JV, and Varsity teams were all victorious. When I arrived at the park, our Varsity team was down 0-11. I watched them score 4 consecutive touchdowns, winning 32-11. More excitement than our Chicago Bears.

Be an Advocate for Victims of Domestic Violence.



True change happens when everyday people contribute to large movements.

You don't have to be famous, on TV, or have a huge online following to make a difference. It starts with the small step of believing the stories of survivors, and then committing to learn more about the problems facing those survivors and their children.

Every day you can be an advocate just by chatting with others at school, work, church, wherever. Let others know you care about domestic violence. Wear purple during Domestic Violence Awareness month in October. When you're asked what it's about, explain why you are concerned about domestic violence.

If someone says, "Well, why don't they just leave," respond with, "Why are the abuser's actions allowed to go unpunished?" Misunderstandings about domestic violence are perpetuated because people simply accept them as the truth. Start a conversation that might lead to a changed mind.

You can let lawmakers know that protecting domestic violence survivors through strong and safe policy is important to you. When Archdiocese of Chicago Domestic Violence Outreach (ACDVO) sends you a call to action on pending legislation, you can reach out to your legislator.

Many victims of domestic violence ask:

"What did I do wrong?

Why is my marriage not working?

I'm afraid for my children.

Why does God not answer my prayers?

I have no one who understands or who will help me.

If I am more patient and understanding,

things might work out.

But I have done all that and nothing changes.

Maybe I just need to try harder."

If you have had these thoughts, you are not alone. Find professional assistance by calling the Crisis Center of South Suburbia 24/7 Domestic Violence Hotline at 708-429-7233. Your call will be answered by a Crisis Intervention Specialist who will connect you with the services you need. Services are free and confidential. If you are in immediate danger, call 911.


