

My Dear People of St. Catherine,

I have been following with sadness and horror and with prayer the unfolding war in the Holy Land: The Hamas terrorist attack and taking of innocent hostages and the ongoing retaliation of Israel. PBS News Hours reports on October 16 that 1,400 Israelis and 2,750 Palestinians have been killed, with at least 199 hostages, including children, captured by Hamas.



On October 7, Bishop David J. Malloy of Rockford, Chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) Committee on International Justice and Peace, has called for prayers for peace in the Holy Land:

"On October 7, the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary, the world watched the operation launched from Gaza and the rapid call to arms from Israel that ensued. Almost 50 years to the day of the launch of the 1973 Arab-Israeli War, once again war is spilling out in the Holy Land. With it brings the mounting casualties and hostilities unfolding on all sides, and increased threats to the Status Quo of the Holy Places among Jews, Muslims, and Christians further dimming any hope for peace."

"The world is once again shocked and horrified by the outbreak of ferocious violence in the Holy Land. Reports have surfaced indicating large numbers of wounded and dead, including many civilians."

"I join with Pope Francis in his call for peace and his condemnation of this widespread outbreak of violence. As he stated in his Sunday audience, "May the attacks and weaponry cease. Please! And let it be understood that terrorism and war do not lead to any resolutions, but only to the death and suffering of so many innocent people."

"May all who love the Holy Land seek to bring about among all the parties engaged in the fighting a cessation of violence, respect for civilian populations and the release of hostages."

"As we pray urgently for peace, we recall especially all the families and individuals suffering from these events. We call on the faithful, and all people of good will to not grow weary and to continue to pray for peace in the land Our Lord, the Prince of Peace, called home."

This past week, a mailing went out to all parishioners, containing a special letter from me, your pastor. This letter was also inserted in the bulletin last weekend. In that letter, I am inviting you to embark on a 5 week journey of discipleship and what stewardship means; a follower of Jesus Christ. Walking with the Lord as His disciples, He asks us to be good and faithful stewards of our time, talent, and treasure. Throughout these weeks, you will hear information about our Enhanced Sunday Offertory Initiative. At the end of these weeks, you will be asked to re-assess your financial commitment your parish, St. Catherine, so that together we can continue to reach more people and share the Good News of the Gospel. So stay tuned.

This is the third weekend for our annual October Count. Our count for Week 1 & 2 is 628 & 773 for an average of 700. In 2019, Pre-COVID, the first two week average was 1006. Please continue to invite others you know to Mass next weekend.

This weekend we welcome our grandparents and grandfriends, who play a special role of passing on the faith to their adult children and to their grandchildren. I offer up this prayer from the USCCB for all grandparents. *Lord God almighty, bless our grandparents with long life, happiness, and health. May they remain constant in your love and be living signs of your presence to their children and grandchildren. We ask this through Christ our Lord. R/. Amen.*



October - The Month of Mary

Besides October being Respect Life month, it is also the month of the Rosary. The Rosary is a beautiful meditative and contemplative prayer where we meditate on the mysteries of our salvation, mainly the life of Jesus, with Mary, our Blessed Mother and ask for her intercession. At the entrance of Church, we have handouts explaining a little more about the Rosary is and how to pray it. There are plenty of good resources to learn more about the Rosary. If the Rosary is not a part of your regular prayer life right now, it's easy to get hands on with this devotion. Here are some suggestions that can help you to get started.

First, we don't have to pray the rosary all at once. Sure, some people might sit down and quietly pray a whole Rosary in one sitting. But we can also choose to divide it up, saying just a decade or two at a time at different points throughout the day: on the way to work, in between errands, in between meetings, while folding laundry or doing dishes.


Second, we can pray it anywhere! The Rosary is like a portable chapel we can keep in our pocket and pull out anytime, anyplace.

We may pray it in Church, in our room, in our office. We also may pray it in the car, on the exercise machine, in the grocery store line, or while cutting the grass or going for a walk. Bringing our hearts into the rhythm of the Rosary is something we can do intermittently throughout the day.


Third, we can pray the Rosary in different ways, customizing it to fit the needs of the moment.

During our St. Catherine of Alexandria Faith Formation classes, we led our students in prayer of the Rosary. It was a wonderful experience, and I encourage you to take time in your daily activities to pray the Rosary. This weekend, I specially ask for prayers for all our Confirmation Candidates, who will have a special Enrollment Mass at 9:30 a.m. Our Lady of the Rosary, Pray for Us!

SCA SCHOOL NEWS




