My Dear People of St. Catherine,



This weekend and next is our Offertory Enhancement Initiative. Over the past several weeks, we have discussed the needs of our parish, reflected on our call to discipleship and the many blessings we've received from God. We also have been prayerfully considering how we can share those blessings with greater intentionality for the mission of our parish family.

Over the past couple of weeks, we have heard from several parishioners regarding our Offertory Enhancement Initiative. Jerry Dillion, a parishioner, shared: *As a father of four boys who went through St. Catherine's and Marist I understand how hard it is to manage your finances while considering your charity donations. Giving to charity is like planting a tree, it may take time to grow but the benefits are long-lasting. For me, I believe our parish is the center of our community: when it lives and loves well, it can be a beacon of faith and hope for all.*

John Farrell, a parishioner, shared: *God has given each of us gifts. In Chapter 12 of 1 Corinthians, St. Paul compares the Church to the Body of Christ. We are many parts but all one body. We all have different gifts that the Lord can use as part of his Church. Our Church needs each of us. We are being called to reflect on how we can share our time, talent and treasure.*

Dan Caddigan, a parishioner, shared: *The parish showed a loss last year and a deficit budget this year. I know many of you, as I have been, faithfully contributing for many years to St. Catherine's. However, I realized that I am still contributing what I gave 20 years ago. Can your household survive on your income from 20 years ago? Consider the parable of the rich man and the poor widow, who puts in two coins into the treasury, giving all that she had to God. Now I'm not suggesting that you give everything that you have to the Church, but who do I want to be more like – the rich man or the poor widow?*
