



My Dear People of St. Catherine,

I begin this letter with mixed emotions. This past Monday, I received the official letter from Cardinal Cupich confirming my retirement on June 30, 2024. I was granted a one year extension when I turned 70 back on September 2, 2023. Cardinal Cupich thanked me for my forty-five years of priesthood and my years of service in a variety of parishes as well as ministry at Quigley, which was the high school preparatory seminary for the Archdiocese. I have been blessed in so many different ways as a Priest of the Lord, for which I give thanks to God. I am also grateful to you, the people of St. Catherine, for so warmly welcoming me nearly 11 years ago. I came to St. Catherine as a direct appointment by Cardinal Francis George, after the sudden death of Fr. Pat Henry. My first experience was the 5K Charger Run, which I enjoyed running yearly since then. I even won medals in my division. Later that day, I returned for the Parish Picnic. I felt so welcomed by everyone I met. During my years of ministry here, I have felt your love and support in so many ways, as I have come to know and love so many of you, as we all have deepened our love for Jesus. I have particularly enjoyed working with our school children for sacramental preparation and celebrations.

What does retirement mean for St. Catherine? This past Wednesday, I spoke with my "extended" staff, people whom I have worked closely with over the years, to inform them of my retirement. This weekend, I am speaking at all Masses. The appointment of a new pastor involves the Priest's Placement Board. Shortly, two priests from the Board will come to St. Catherine to first meet the parish extended staff, and then meet with the parish leadership, asking for their input to help the Placement Board in their pastor recommendations. All parishioners will also have the opportunity to give input by completing a survey. (This survey is different from the Parish Survey last spring.) These surveys will be available in church this weekend. This process is currently taking place throughout the Archdiocese with parishes having an opening for a pastor. During this process, priests looking to be pastor may also visit us to learn more about the parish. In a couple of months, the pastor appointments will then come out. Cardinal Cupich will review the Placement Board's recommendations and make the final appointment.

What does retirement mean for me? First, I will continue to be your involved pastor through the end of June. There are projects currently taking place, including a new church sound system, remodeling of the vestibule, and expansion of Alpha to Small Transformative Faith Sharing Groups. During this time, I will also have to take more time for myself to prepare for my retirement. This includes the fundamental things like cleaning out my rooms and packing up. It's amazing what one accumulates over 11 years. One does not retire from being a priest. I look forward to helping out sacramentally in parishes, as I celebrate Mass which gives me much joy. I will continue to be involved with the Archdiocese of Chicago as a Dean of nine surrounding parishes. I will enjoy more visits with family and friends. I will be taking a sabbatical which allows more time for myself. Please pray for me, as I pray for you, and the parish of St. Catherine.


Direction For Our Times Lay Apostles of the Returning King (ARK)


The following is the first paragraph by Kathryn Clarke from her booklet, An Invitation:










When a friend tells us of an illness or a difficult time in their life, we often respond, "I will keep you in my prayers". Eucharistic Adoration is a rewarding way to keep this promise. We have a wonderful way of doing this with these prayer cards in our Adoration Chapel. They are located at the sign-in sheet for adorers; envelope included. This can be something to do in the New Year!

Dear Community of Faith,

The father of my friend of almost 12 years died in December 2023. For most of his life, he was a member of a small Catholic church near his house. He had been unable to attend Sunday services for the past 3 years; but about a month before he died, during one of my visits, he said to me, "I still try to keep up with my Sunday School lesson every week."

At age 85, this frail, somewhat discouraged man still felt strongly committed to learning more about his faith and the Bible.

The Catholic Church has always stressed and supported educating children in the faith. But the Second Vatican Council led to new research on adult education and to many effective adult study materials. In the United States, much of this material emerged after 1979.

In "Our Hearts Were Burning Within Us," (A Pastoral Plan for Adult Faith Formation in the United States), the Bishops wrote, "Disciples young and old are called by name to go into the vineyard. In responding to this call, adults have the greatest responsibilities and the capacity to live the Christian message in its fully developed form. Their formation in faith is essential for the Church to carry out its mandate to proclaim the Good News of Jesus to the world."

"The Church" means us.

As adults, it is important to stay informed about what the Church teaches regarding our faith. The term "faith formation," used by the Bishops, implies that we should not only read and study but also focus on developing a deep and ongoing relationship with God. This involves internalizing our beliefs so that they guide our decisions, commitments, and actions. A mature adult's faith transforms us daily, enabling us to grow spiritually and become better versions of ourselves.

You are never too old to be called by God. Get up again and start proclaiming God to the next generation.

Thanks to determined and hard-working lay people and clergy, our own Scripture Study at St. Catherine's usually takes place every Thursday evening in the school library and every Friday morning in the Fr. Lion Center. Every adult is invited to participate. No registration required. They are currently studying the Bible Timeline with Jeff Cavins until February 8th. In addition to this, a great way to learn more about your faith is to become a catechist. Together we learn more about our Catholic faith, growth in our understanding of God, and guide children towards God.

In this new year, let's explore our Catholic faith. One is never too old to learn.




