



My Dear People of St. Catherine,

The freezing cold of last week affected us all. With the temperatures moderating a little, we can return now to our normal routines. Because Mass attendance was understandably down last week, I want to make sure that you are aware of the announcement I made last week at the Masses:



I speak to you this weekend with mixed emotions. This past Monday I received a letter from Cardinal Cupich confirming my retirement effective June 30. He had granted me a one year extension for this current year. I am one of the last of the ordination Class of 1978 to retire. I have been blessed in so many different ways as a Priest of the Lord. I am also grateful to you, the people of St. Catherine for your support and love for these 11 years as your pastor. With Jesus as the vine, we have worked together in the vineyard of the Lord as His disciples, bearing much fruit. I have enjoyed being your pastor. I have fallen in love with St. Catherine, and I love you. The Priests Placement Board now begins the process for the selection of a new pastor. I will continue to be your working pastor until the end of June. My retirement is from the administrative responsibilities of a pastor, not from priesthood. I look forward, not without some anxiousness, to my next stage of priesthood. My good friend, Fr. Ken Fleck, is a good example for me of a retired priest who continues to enjoy ministry. Please read my bulletin letter (inserted into this weekend's bulletin), which goes into more detail about the process of selecting a pastor as well as my hopes in retirement. Inserted into the bulletin is a short 3 question survey from the Priests Placement Board to help with the selection of a new pastor. Please return by next weekend. By the way, this stole, which I just pulled out of storage, was made by my mother 45 years ago, when I was ordained a priest. Please pray for me in these upcoming months, as I will pray for you. God bless.

The Priests Placement Board "Survey of Parishioners regarding New Pastor Selection" has been inserted once again into the bulletin. The deadline for returning has been extended through Sunday, January 28. It's only 3 questions. Please take the time to complete.

The Archdiocese for quite a while has given permission, since the easing of COVID-19 restrictions, for resuming the practice of receiving under both kinds "Species," the sacred bread and wine, the Body and Blood of Christ. At St. Catherine, we have been very cautious in resuming this practice. We will resume this practice only at the 9:30am Mass to begin with. If you also wish to receive the Precious Blood, a Minister of the Eucharist will be on the right side as you come forward to receive our Lord, who will wipe the rim of the cup after every reception. Dipping the Eucharist you have received into the sacred wine, (Intinction) is NOT allowed. We continue to be very cautious with reception under both kinds. Please refrain from receiving if you feel at all sick. Jesus is fully present whether one receives Holy Communion as only one kind or under both kinds. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, Communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace. For pastoral reasons this manner of receiving Communion has been legitimately established as the most common form in the Latin rite. But 'the sign of Communion is more complete when given under both kinds, since in that form the sign of the Eucharistic meal appears more clearly.'..."(No. 1390). What is most important is to come to Mass and receive our

Lord in Holy Communion.






The following is the first paragraph by Kathryn Clarke from her booklet, An Invitation:







