

Carlo Acutis had a deep devotion to the Eucharist from the first time he received Jesus in the Eucharist at age 7. He wanted









SCA SCHOOL NEWS

Assessing Students' Academic Progress

There are many ways that we assess student progress at SCA. Of course there are traditional assessments such as tests, essays, and projects. There are also quizzes, lab reports, artwork, and in-class assignments. Teachers utilize quizzes, entry and exit slips, and technology based work to check on student progress. Some of these measures are formative (for learning) and others are summative (of learning.)



i-Ready

The Archdiocese uses the i-Ready assessments to help measure student academic progress. Each week, we encourage students to take and pass two i-Ready lessons in both reading and math. From this data, teachers can create groupings of students who have similar profiles of what they have mastered and where they need to continue to grow. Administratively, we can use the data to see where we might need to adjust the curriculum to better meet student needs.



Archdiocesan Religion Assessment

In addition to the teacher prepared formative and summative assessments and i-Ready assessments, the Archdiocese also has a system-wide religion assessment. These assessments measure how well students are meeting the standards set forth by the Archdiocese for religious instruction.



Diagnostics

Three times a year students take diagnostic i-Ready exams. They take them at the beginning of the year, in mid January to early February, and again in May. The results of the diagnostic exams allow us to measure student academic performance as the year progresses.





These four 8th graders have completed all of their lessons in either math or reading for i-Ready.

Celebrating Successes


Well over 20 of our 7th and 8th grade students have finished all of their i-Ready lessons or their diagnostic results show they have mastered all they needed to learn. We celebrate their success after Mass with public recognition. They also get a sign for their locker to recognize their achievement.




