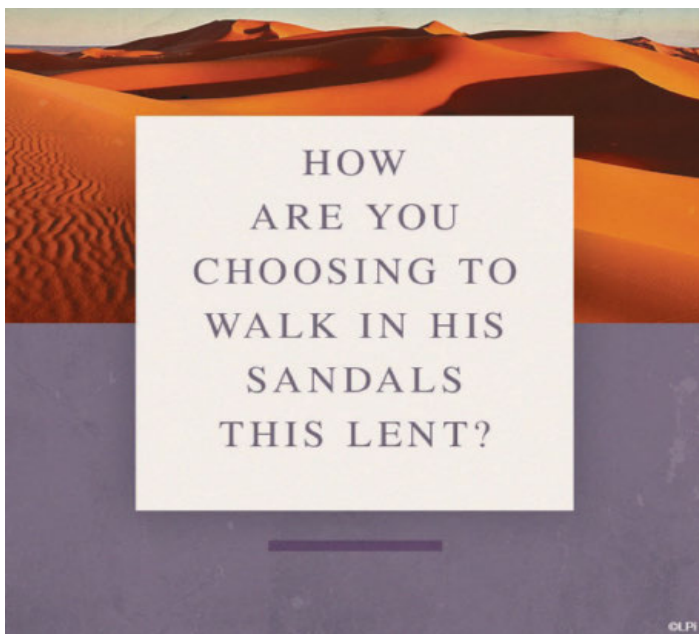
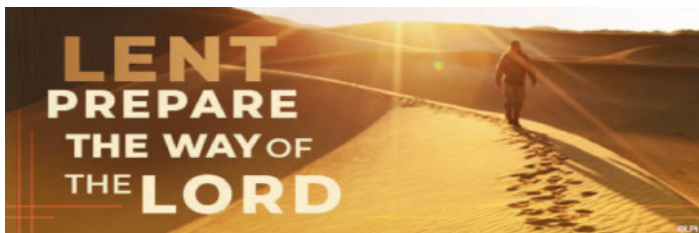

## First Sunday of Lent

**An Opportunity this Lent to be led by the Holy Spirit**  
**Genesis 9: 8-15; 1 Peter 3: 18-22; Mark 1: 12-15**

Baptism is at the heart of our readings on this First Sunday of Lent. The Catechism of the Catholic Church makes it clear that Baptism is perhaps the major factor in our Catholic lives. #213 of the Catechism states: "Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit, and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn." Our Lenten journeys need to reflect our response to our Baptismal call and to help us set how we are going to live out that call in our daily lives.

The first reading from Genesis opens with God making a covenant with His people. The Lord says, "I am now establishing my covenant with you, and with your descendants after you." No matter how we define how we are descended from Noah and the handful of people on the Ark, God's covenant includes us. Then God made a sign of His covenant with a rainbow: "I set my bow in the clouds as a sign of my covenant between me and the earth." If rainbows have always seemed special to you, they should. Every time we see a rainbow, we should be reminded of God's love for us and His promise of salvation to us.

The other key ingredient to this first reading has to do with Baptism. As we will see in the second reading from 1 Peter, the flood is compared to the waters of Baptism. Noah is baptized in a spiritual sense. We must see that Baptism has to do with the spirit. It may be called "cleansing" but it is a cleansing of the SOUL, not of the body. We have been cleansed and our Lenten expedition, like that of the Ark, is to seek and renew that spiritual cleansing.

St. Peter makes a comparison between Baptism and the flood experienced by Noah and his family: "This prefigured Baptism, which saves you now. It is not a removal of dirt from the body, but an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ." We are saved, just as Noah and his family were, by the waters of Baptism. You may have heard the phrase "waters of life." Those waters we receive when baptized cleanse the very core of our beings. We receive new life, but it is not life in the meaning we understand it on this earth. It is eternal life. To achieve that, however, requires us to strive for good and righteousness. Right now, during this Lenten season, we have the opportunity to take steps toward that life of righteousness to which we are called.

The Gospel from Mark reports the beginning of Jesus' 40 days in the desert. These 40 days parallel the 40 days of Lent which we began just a few days ago.

Several years ago, on Ash Wednesday, Pope Benedict XVI pointed out that like the Lord, we find ourselves in the desert quite often because of "secularism and the culture of materialism." Discipleship is a lifestyle which helps us combat these challenges. It is also worth mentioning that according to the Gospel "The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert." The Greek word which is translated as "drove" might also be translated as "led." To be sure, this is a time, when we need to be led by the Holy Spirit, a time when like Jesus Himself, we need to turn to the Spirit and the Angels for help and support. Lent is an opportunity, and we need to seize it.

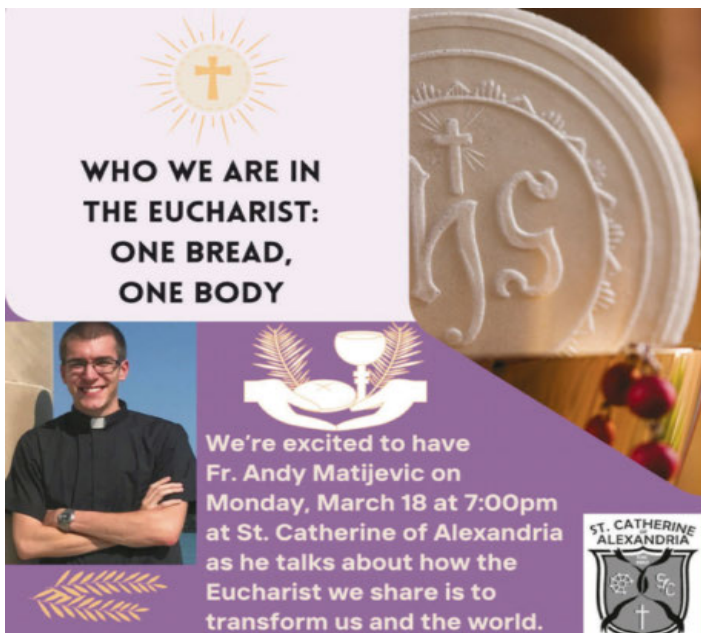

My Dear People of St. Catherine,

I would like to share with you two items of importance:



As I recently announced, I will be retiring from being your pastor at the end of June. I am grateful for the many blessings I have received during my 45 years of priesthood and my 11 years of being your pastor at St. Catherine. I will continue to serve as a priest of the Archdiocese. The Priest Placement Board has begun the process of selecting a new pastor. I thank the many of you who completed the New Pastor Survey, which shows the support and love you have for your parish. Your responses will be reviewed by the Placement Board. Three weeks ago, two priests from the Placement Board had a meeting with the Parish and School Staff (9 total), following a second meeting with Parish Leadership (25 total). Fr. Kevin McCray and Fr. Stan Kuca complimented the discussion of both groups. The placement board is now compiling a list of parishes in need of a new pastor and a list of priests desiring to be considered a pastor. The Placement Board will start meeting at the end of the month to begin discerning new pastor placements. Their recommendations will be given to Cardinal Cupich later in March. Then in April, Cardinal Cupich will make public his choices for the appointment of pastors for parishes in need of a new pastor, including the name of the new pastor for St. Catherine of Alexandria. These Assignments are effective July 1.

Now for some more news. In addition to being your pastor, I am also the Dean of eight surrounding parishes. As Dean, I have the responsibility of overseeing these parishes. About three weeks ago, Cardinal Cupich appointed me as the administrator of one of these parishes, our neighbor, St. Christina. Their pastor is no longer at St. Christina, moving now to another aspect of priestly ministry. I wish him well. As administrator, I will be more involved with St. Christina. The parish has two good priests, Fr. Wayne Swida and Fr. Tom Bernas. They will be responsible for the spiritual well-being of the parish, and I will work with them. St. Christina also has a very capable staff, whom I will also work with. An administrator does not make major decisions. As I was already beginning the planning for my retirement, now I also have this added responsibility, which I surely was not planning on. I will continue to live at St. Catherine, but you may not see me around quite as much. I will do my best, with the help of God, to be a good pastor and a good administrator through the end of June, when new pastors will begin serving in both parishes. Please keep St. Christina, St. Catherine, and me in your prayers.

Dear Community of St. Catherine:

Many Christians throughout the world observe Lent. Catholic, Orthodox, and many Protestants benefit from this annual season of sacrifice and simplicity. For non-Christians, the observance of Lent may seem odd, since Christians voluntarily make sacrifices. Christians are simply imitating the practices and teachings of Jesus. Lent is a period of fasting leading up to Easter. The season is rooted in the 40-day fast of Jesus in the wilderness. Catholic Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends right before the evening Masses of Holy Thursday. Lent, as a penitential season, is the time for us to turn rad-i-cal-ly back to God; to experience true conversion and repentance. This conversion, however, is primarily the work of grace, according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (§1432). Although penance is a calling of every Catholic throughout his or her life, Lent is a season specially marked out for the Church to be 'united among themselves by common observance' of it (Code of Canon Law, §1249). It is a way of growing in faith together.

#### **Understanding the basic facts about Lent:**

Liturgical Color(s): Violet (Purple)

Type of Holiday: Fast, spiritual cleanse

Duration: The traditional Lenten fast is observed for 40 days, starting on Ash Wednesday, going through Holy Week, excluding Sundays.

Celebrates/Symbolizes: Jesus' wilderness fast;  
Preparation for Easter

Scriptural References: Matthew 4:1-11; Luke 4:1-13

During Lent, people tend to observe it in different ways. Some choose to go on a diet while others may see Catholic co-workers with ashes on their heads or fast-food restaurants selling fish sandwiches. As we begin the Lenten season, I invite you to participate in observing it. At St. Catherine of Alexandria, we have planned several events to foster community within our parish, including Stations of the Cross every Friday, Fish Frys, the Prayer of the Rosary every Wednesday, and an opportunity to come to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. All are welcome to join us as we come together as one body.

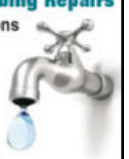

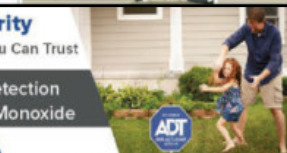
