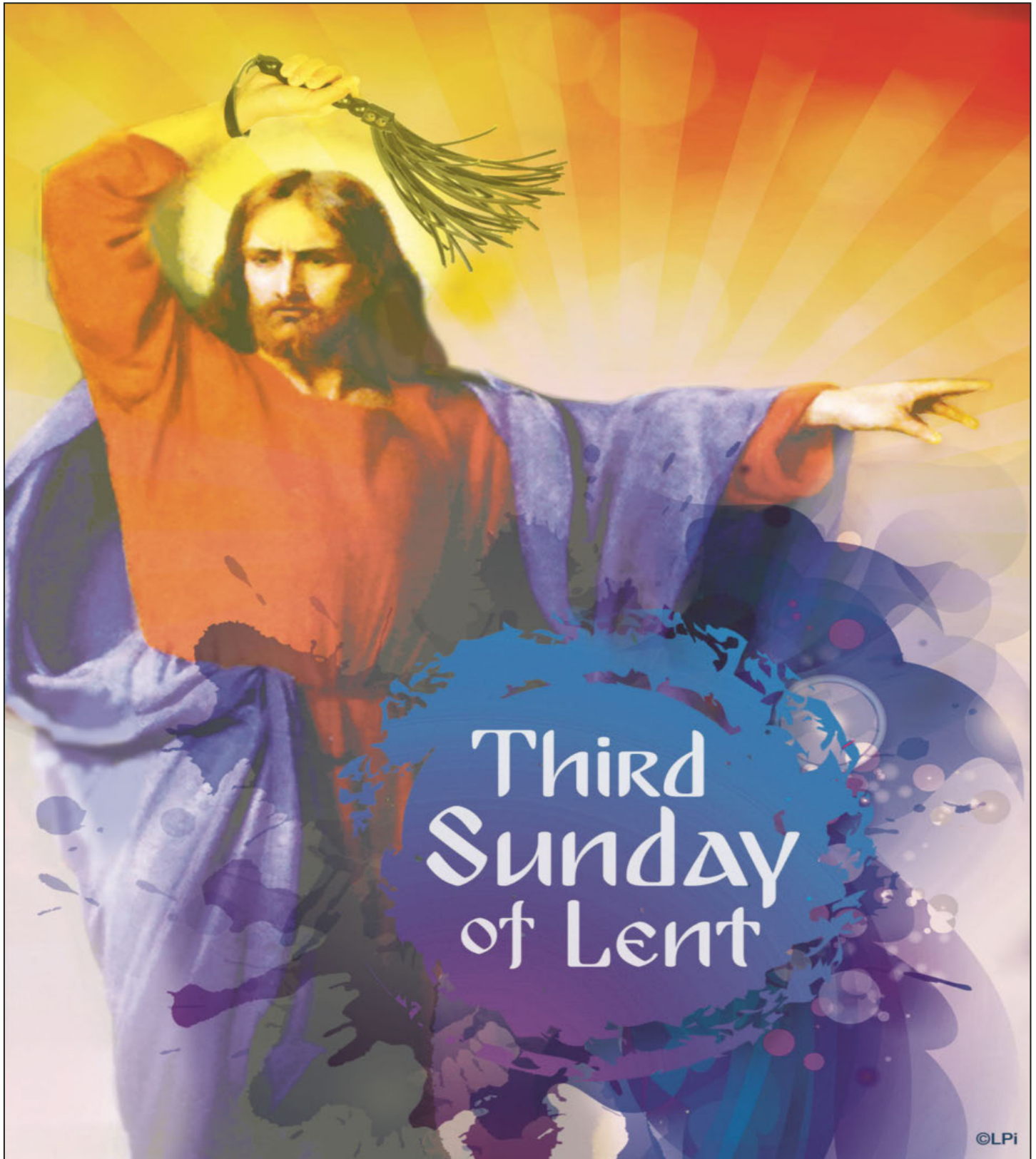

## Corporal Works of Mercy The Seven Corporal Works of Mercy

Corporal Works of Mercy are those that tend to bodily needs. In (Matthew 25:31-46, in the Judgment of Nations six specific Works of Mercy are enumerated, although not this precise list — as the reason for the salvation of the saved, and the omission of them as the reason for damnation. The last work of mercy, burying the dead, comes from the Book of Tobit. [3][4]

**To feed the hungry:** "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat." Mt. 25:35

**To give drink to the thirsty:** "...I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink..." Mt. 25:35

**To clothe the naked:** "I was naked and you clothed me..." Mt. 25:36

**To visit the imprisoned:** "I was in prison and you came to me." Mt. 25:36

**To shelter the homeless:** "...I was a stranger and you took me in..." Mt. 25:35

**To visit the sick:** "...I was sick and you cared for me..." Mt. 25:36

**To bury the dead:** "Amen, I say to you, insofar as you did it for one of these least of my brothers, you did it for me." Mt. 25:40

### Welcoming our New Neighbors Wednesday, January 31, 2024

During a recent meeting, several priests shared with me the concerns of parishioners to know more about what the archdiocese has been doing to care for recently arrived migrants and asylum seekers. What follows is a brief summary, which I ask you to share with friends and neighbors, if it would be helpful.

Since the start of the influx of new arrivals to the Chicago area, the archdiocese, through Catholic Charities and our parishes, has partnered with government and community leaders to connect newcomers with safe, long-term housing and provide resources to meet their basic needs. We have a dedicated team of more than 200 bilingual staff working on the frontlines each day, serving with courageous and faith-filled compassion, hope and joy.

Together with generous philanthropic support, our parishes and Catholic Charities have distributed hundreds of essential items, such as weekly transit cards and blankets to new arrivals staying at District 1 police station and O'Hare International Airport. We continue to serve thousands through our parishes and Catholic Charities' anchor programs at community centers across Lake and Cook counties, by providing fresh food through our pantries, welcoming them as guests to our community suppers and connecting them to other services.

Catholic Charities is deploying an integrated, three-pronged approach to support new arrivals. Rapid Response and Mission Engagement teams work in collaboration with parish, community and government partners to mobilize and coordinate resources, plan and implement initiatives and distribute help and materials expeditiously and with dignity. Additionally, Charities staff assist migrants who wish to reunite with family and friends in other parts of the U.S.





For instance, in December 2022, Catholic Charities responded to the city and state's call to help transition migrants out of suburban hotels and city shelters. In partnership with the Illinois Department of Human Services, Chicago's Department of Family and Support Services and the Mayor's Office, we connect new arrivals with private landlords.

The city provides Catholic Charities a caseload of people eligible for state-funded emergency rental assistance. Charities case managers then work with individuals and families to complete a housing needs assessment, and then match them to landlords with available, affordable apartments. Charities' partners process emergency rental applications, help with move-in and support community integration.

As the numbers grow, Catholic Charities has committed to increasing its pace, helping 500 households each month find housing. To that end, Catholic Charities continues to seek responsible and reputable landlords to continue renting to our newest neighbors.

Catholic Charities is also partnering with the Resurrection Project to assist eligible new arrivals with applying for work authorization and Temporary Protection Status. This includes reviewing supporting documentation, providing interpretation and translation and helping newcomers complete their applications.

Again, in collaboration with our parishes, Catholic Charities, thanks to the financial support from donors, continues to accompany families in their resettlement and community integration over their first months in Chicago. This includes providing crisis assistance to new arrivals, such as blankets, transit cards and other essentials. Our food pantries serve new arrivals, especially in Cicero and in Chicago's Back-of-the-Yards neighborhood. Our daily community supper programs in many parishes and in downtown Chicago and Cicero have doubled in size to welcome hundreds of migrant families, many with young children and babies. Our domestic violence team is responding to many calls for help from migrants.

In sum, the Catholic Church has been at the forefront of responding to the needs of migrants and asylum seekers. The table below offers some helpful statistics, which offers a snapshot of all that we are doing. I am so grateful to our pastors, parishioners and especially Catholic Charities, which is taking the lead in coordinating our efforts.

Total arrivals to Chicago from Texas since August 2022, reported by the City of Chicago: 34,229

Total individuals directly supported by Catholic Charities and Parish Care Initiatives: 16,489

Adults and children reunited with families outside Chicago: 3,748

Individuals living in shelters and hotels who have been connected to housing: 11,125

Individuals assisted work authorization and Temporary Protection Status applications: 1,400

Individuals housed and accompanied through the Parish Family Sponsorship Program: 216 (95 families)

## History Comes Alive

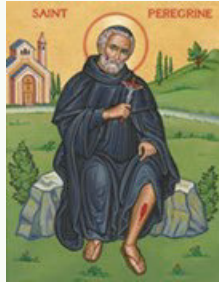

St. Peregrine is the patron saint for persons suffering from illnesses of all types in particular cancer. Saint Peregrine was healed of a cancerous ulcer on his leg which was considered beyond saving. The fame of this event in 1325 spread rapidly around the western Church.

Christians, and especially the sick, began to invoke his name and seek his intercession for the relief of their suffering and even for a cure from sickness. The canonization of St. Peregrine in 1726 increased people's devotion to him which spread to the universal Church.

St. Catherine of Alexandria will begin offering a Novena to St. Peregrine at 7:00pm in the church. The Novena will be held for 9 Mondays. All are welcome.

**PREPARING OURSELVES THIS LENT THROUGH PRAYER**

Dear St. Catherine Community:

As Christians, we all know that Holy Week and Easter are really important times in our spiritual lives. And because of that, we spend forty days in Lent getting ourselves ready for these special occasions. We do this by taking the time to connect with God through prayer.

There are so many ways to pray, but some methods can be especially helpful in preparing ourselves for Lent. If you're looking for some prayer advice during Lent, I've got some great suggestions for you. Why not use this time to create prayer habits that will stay with you long after Lent is over? That way, you can continue to grow and deepen your faith even after the season has ended. And don't worry about trying to do everything at once. Just pick one or two of the prayer methods mentioned and focus on those. That way, you can fully enjoy the journey towards Easter that is Lent. Have fun!

**Prayer Practices – Methods:**

**Renew Yourself through Personal Reflective Prayer.** Every morning or at bedtime, choose a small passage of the Bible and reflect on it. If there is no Bible near, pray for a moment, and thank God for the beginning and end of the day given to us.

**Pray the Stations of the Cross:** Alone or in a group, this is a wonderful way to reflect on the most incredible sacrifice Jesus did for all of us. (Every Friday at 6:30pm, St. Catherine's offers this prayer; everyone can join us.— Good Friday-3:00pm).

**Pray the Rosary:** What better way to understand Jesus' suffering than through Mary. You may come every Wednesday during Lent to St. Catherine and pray with us at 6:30pm; or at home, take out your Rosary and dedicate some time to Mary. If short on time, pray one decade at that time. Our 5th grade students created a beautiful Rosary this past Sunday, and they made one for their families as well. If you need a Rosary, please stop by the church vestibule, you will find extra Rosaries there.

**Pray with Children or as a Family:** As you know, children learn more by seeing than by being told. So yes, take a small moment during meals to pray as a family. Little ones pick up very quickly from their parent's habits.

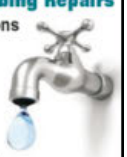

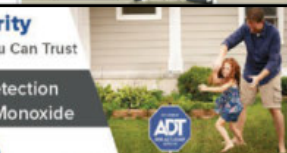
